This document highlights the major changes and fixes for Release 1.9.0.13.1 of Micros Supply Chain myCreations.

Overview

Micros Supply Chain myCreations is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

The suite is composed of the following applications:

- myLibrary - enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- myProduct - supports the development of products and production specifications.
- myProject - supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- mySupplier - enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

Functional Enhancements

Note: Where new fields or User Interface (UI) changes are introduced as part of a change, the portal owner may need to set up any new system text and associated translations to support it.

The following functional enhancements are included in this release:

User Advanced Search

Tesseract Ref 94051

For Portal Owner users, the Advanced search facility within mySupplier> Users is changed to allow searching of users against specific sites. The selection of Site is allowed within the Field drop-down list in the Advanced Search facility.

For supplier users, the Advanced search facility within myCompany> Users is changed to allow searching of users against specific sites. The selection of Site is allowed within the Field drop-down list in the Advanced Search facility.

myProject - Make Top Level Projects

Users are now able to use the Change Parent action on a project to make the project appear at the highest level. This is done by clicking the MAKE TOP-LEVEL PROJECT button within the Change Parent dialogue which clears the Parent Project field on the current project.

TRUNKONENINE-29 Tesseract Ref 75720	An unfriendly error message appeared when alert response encountered an error. The email message sent to the user, who submits an alert response which fails to send, now informs the user to report the issue giving a specific error ID which should help Development establish what has happened. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-47	Filters were not working in the Alerts selector. The Alerts selector now correctly applies filters to the available selections. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-48	The system crashed when editing an Alert attachment. The system no longer crashes when editing an Alert attachment. Impact on existing installation: None expected

TRUNKONEEIGHT-217 Tesseract Ref 94242	<p>The system crashed when attempting to progress a CNF specification to Collaborative Draft.</p> <p>The system no longer crashes when progressing a migrated specification that has components with no associated supplier rows.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

TRUNKONEEIGHT-222 Tesseract Ref 85750	<p>The system crashed when validating the Recipe and Raw Materials section.</p> <p>The system correctly handles recipes where a compound name and a component of field have the same name.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-229 Tesseract Ref 94055	<p>Areas in the Raw Materials countries selectors for Food and FNF Specifications could not be selected.</p> <p>The Country selectors (Country Where Processed and Country of Origin) on the Raw Materials page now allow the selection of Areas.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-235 Tesseract Ref 86793	<p>The system crashed when copying a migrated specification.</p> <p>The system now allows the copying of a migrated specification where a User Defined Field (custom field) within one (or more) of its sections has not been assigned a value.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-236 Tesseract Ref 93765	<p>The system crashed when attempting to change the status of a copied specification.</p> <p>The system now allows the progression of a specification which meets the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Has been copied from another specification which had an allergen that needed to be declared, but had not (that is, a reason had been entered in the Reasons for Not Declaring table). ■ The allergen described above had been subsequently made inactive. <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

TRUNKONEEIGHT-240	<p>A generated Pack Copy was incomplete.</p> <p>The system now generates a complete pack copy.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-243 Tesseract Ref 94912	<p>A specification could not progress or be edited due to the section names not being unique.</p> <p>In order to deal with this scenario, the system no longer validates that section names are unique whenever a user moves the status of a specification backwards to a status that allows the specification to be edited. Section names are only validated if the user is moving the specification forward through the workflow.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-245 Tesseract Ref 94904	<p>When making a specification active, the list of product technologists was not complete.</p> <p>The system now correctly lists all users who have been assigned to Show in List of Product Technologists within their user record.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-246	<p>Products could not be created using the myProduct Inbound API when using the invoicing reference.</p> <p>The API now allows the creation of products using the invoicing reference.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-248	<p>Site information was missing from the Pack Copy header.</p> <p>The system now includes site information within the Pack Copy header for specifications set up as multi-variant.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-252 Tesseract Ref 94248	<p>A Terminal Validation error occurred when progressing a specification from Pack Copy Sent.</p> <p>The system no longer validates for active ingredients at Pack Copy Sent.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

TRUNKONEEIGHT-267 Tesseract Ref 95670	The Origin of Meat or Fish in the pack copy only showed the first entry. The system now includes all entries found within the Origins table in the Pack Copy. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-28	The table buttons were active on a locked Produce Specification. Table buttons are no longer available to use on a locked Produce Specification. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-33	The Recipe Table could be edited at Pack Copy Sent. The Recipe Table is no longer editable in specifications which are at Pack Copy Sent. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-55 Tesseract Ref 95378	Supplier Details were lost when copying the Component Section from another CNF Specification. The Supplier Details in copied specifications no longer have any reference to the originating specification, therefore, this problem should no longer occur. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-59	An error occurred when calling the Product Specification web service. A correction is made in the schema which now allows calls to be made without causing an error. Impact on existing installation: None expected

TRUNKONEEIGHT-207	The system crashed when opening a Project or Product in the Project list view. The system no longer allows a user to set the Parent Project field to any of the projects below it. Impact on existing installation: None expected

TRUNKONEEIGHT-237 Tesseract Ref 94283	<p>The system crashed when deleting a saved view within the Activities List View.</p> <p>The system no longer crashes when a saved view is deleted within the Activities option.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-244 Tesseract Ref 94728	<p>The supplier visible flag cannot be set on Activity Template attachments or Project Template attachments.</p> <p>The system now allows this to be set when an attachment is added to either a Project or Activity Template.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-247 Tesseract Ref 94950	<p>Sub-Projects were not ordered alphabetically in hierarchy views.</p> <p>Sub-Projects are now correctly ordered within the hierarchy views.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONENINE-50	<p>The system crashed when attempting to open the Linked Records page on a project when links were in place.</p> <p>The system no longer crashes when a user clicks the Linked Records page on a project which has links to records in place.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

TRUNKONEEIGHT-158	<p>Validation was not working correctly on the Audit Reference Field.</p> <p>The system no longer allows a non-unique reference to be used in this field which is checked before the record is saved.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-230 Tesseract Ref 93964	<p>Auditors were not listed in alphabetical order for internal audits.</p> <p>When adding auditors to an audit through the audit person present table, the system now lists the auditors in alphabetical order.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-249 Tesseract Ref 92925	The system crashed when opening a visit issue without an issue type assigned. For environments where the issue type is not mandatory, the system no longer crashes when opening an issue without an issue type. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONENINE-49	The system produced an error when trying to print a checklist. This option is removed as checklists can be printed when printing an Audit. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONENINE-52	The system crashed when block answering a checklist with an answer that required mandatory comments. The system no longer crashes when block answering a checklist containing questions requiring mandatory comments. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-227 Tesseract Ref 93834	The preview of the Scorecard Questions on the Scorecard Template did not reflect how the questions would appear in Scorecards that used that template. The preview of questions now correctly orders the questions as they would appear in the Scorecard. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-258	The Scorecard Template was taking a long time to save. The save time is reduced when editing a template that has in excess of 100 future scorecards. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-263	Scorecard Templates could be edited even though a batch job was running which could change it. The system now keeps a lock on a scorecard template until the Change Scorecard batch job has completed. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-273	The system crashed when editing Future Scorecards while a Scorecard Template change job was running. The system now schedules and runs the template change batch jobs out of hours which helps to ensure that scorecards are not being edited. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-255	A Test Report could not be loaded unless the user was logged on as a Surveillance Laboratory User. The system now allows Test Reports to be uploaded by any user as long as they have the SURVEILLANCE TEST UPLOADER authority profile. Impact on existing installation: None expected
