This document highlights the major changes and fixes for Release 1.9.0.18 of Micros Supply Chain myCreations.

Overview

Micros Supply Chain myCreations is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

The suite is composed of the following applications:

- myLibrary - enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- myProduct - supports the development of products and production specifications.
- myProject - supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- mySupplier - enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

Table 1 Administration Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONENINE-112 Tesseract Ref 103598	Rules could not be set up to show or hide fields on records. It is now possible to set up rules to control fields being visible to or hidden from users on records. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Table 2 Alerts Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-415 Tesseract Ref 103852	Long processing times occurred for alerts with a high number of recipients. The performance of the system has been improved so that the processing of alerts with many recipients and questions takes less time to process. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Table 3 mySupplier Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-413 Tesseract Ref 96149 and 95108	A site which had no supplier could not be delisted. The system now allows the status of a site without a supplier to be set to DELISTED. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Table 4 myProduct Fixed Issues

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONENINE-107	Supplier users were able to amend Allergen Overrides. Supplier users are now prevented from amending allergen overrides. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-418	Visibility of the FROM and TO picklists was poor when carrying out a Global Change. The FROM and TO picklists used within the Change myProduct Responsibility and Change myProduct Produce Responsibility Global Change screens now expand to the space required to see all the values. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-419	No Storage Section name was shown on an FNF Specification. The system now shows all the section names in an FNF specification where there are multiple storage sections. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-420 Tesseract Ref 98216	Duplicate allergen validation error messages were shown. The system no longer displays duplicate allergen validation error messages. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Table 4 (Cont.) myProduct Fixed Issues

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-422 Tesseract Ref 102482	Printer information was missing from the Pack Copy. The Pack Copy now displays printer information for multiple printers. Impact on existing installation: None expected. Where there has been more than one printer specified within a specification, it may be advisable to check the Pack Copy.
TRUNKONEEIGHT-423 Tesseract Ref 105460	New allergen species information could not be selected within the Allergens Section. The system now allows the selection of new allergen species information added to the system. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-427	The Product Records List View was slow to render. Performance improvements have been made to reduce the time taken to display the Product Record list views. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Table 5 myProject Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-416 Tesseract Ref 103488	The system crashed when linking from a product specification to a Project. The system no longer crashes when linking a product specification to a Project where the user has insufficient permissions or access to the project. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-421 Tesseract Ref 98852	The system crashed when setting a third party audit to completed. The system no longer crashes when a third party audit is set to completed where there are no allowable scores. Impact on existing installation: None expected

Table 7 Scorecards Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
TRUNKONEEIGHT-428 Tesseract Ref 99763	The Scorecards by Status List View timed out. Performance improvements have been made to prevent the list view from timing out. Impact on existing installation: None expected
