Note: The rebranding for the latest version of this documentation set is in development as part of post MICROS acquisition activities. References to former MICROS product names may exist throughout the existing documentation set.

This document highlights the major changes and fixes for Release 1.9.0.23 of Micros Supply Chain myCreations.

Overview

Micros Supply Chain myCreations is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

The suite is composed of the following applications:

- myLibrary - enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- myProduct - supports the development of products and production specifications.
- myProject - supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- mySupplier - enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

Functional Enhancement

The following functional enhancement is included in this release:

myProduct Nutrition Table Support for South African Legislation

Defect Number: 24391673

In order to meet South African legislation requirements, a new field is added to the nutrient glossary called "Space before unit." This can be used to add a space between the nutrients value and the units when it is displayed in the Back of Pack Declaration table. For example, Fat could be set up to show 10 g instead of 10g.

Fixed Issues

The following tables list issues fixed in this release:

Table 1 General Fixed Issues

Defect Number	Description
24598507	Performance improvements are made to the way the system handles embedded List Views, such as the list of specifications within a site record. These List Views now only refresh once when the record is opened rather than constantly refreshing whilst the record is open.
24659476, 25359371	The system no longer allows users to select the "Mark as Read" action for a news item if the news item has been archived.
24807106	A fix is applied so that the default set of roles are generated when a new environment is created.

Table 2 Administration Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
24703676	The Contact Roles selector in the PRI01 email template is now populated when the Associated To field has been set to "Specification." An error no longer occurs when a Produce specification is approved and there is no Contact Role set in the To/ External recipients field of the PRI01 email template.

Table 3 Alerts Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
24904765	When sending an alert marked urgent, the system now shows "-Urgent" on the subject line of the email instead of "?-Urgent?".

Table 4 mySupplier Fixed Issue

Defect Number	Description
24960822	The system no longer gives an error when printing a site record either from the List View of sites or when viewing a site record.

Table 5 myProduct Fixed Issues

Defect Number	Description
23320843	Where selections are made using the Editable Text Selector, these are now listed in the same order in the Pack Copy as they are seen on screen within the specification.
23665009	The system now only shows specifications that require review when they are actually due.
23857529	The Servings per Package shown on the Nutrition panel is now displayed according to the Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) standards.
24367856	Supplier users are now able to see a task in the Task App covering produce specifications which are awaiting supplier approval.

Table 5 (Cont.) myProduct Fixed Issues

Defect Number	Description
24375090	The Specification Type field remains editable if a specification has not been linked to the Product Record (as per other fields). Therefore, if the user has the necessary access rights to edit the Product Record, it is at a status where it can be edited, and no specifications have yet been linked to it, then the Specification Type will be editable. If the Product Record does have any specifications linked to it, if the user attempts to change the type to something different to that of the specifications, validation prevents the change, with the message: <i>Specification Type must be consistent between Product Record and any linked Specifications.</i>
24497775	The nutrition section validation now reports an error to make the user aware that Total Sugar + Starch cannot be greater than Carbohydrate.
24569171	An FNF specification now shows the FNF Ingredient field when a new version is created.
24606010	The system now allows the Provide Ingredient Information field within an FNF specification to be set and saved correctly.
24660265	The system now correctly rounds the QUID output within the ingredients list according to EU and ANZ regulations.
24793896	The system now uses the calculation rules correctly for Energy for a specification that has been set to use the Korean legislation.
24835271	The system allows sites to be de-selected from a produce specification without any issues.
24842653	An error is no longer produced when a new version of a specification is created.
24909654, 24926268, 25379876	The system now allows a Food specification to be progressed correctly when Micro tests have been added within the Finished Product Standards section.
24918229	Produce specifications, with multiple products covered, can now be progressed without the system reporting an error regarding site section coverage.
24932877	An error no longer occurs when progressing a specification to Collaborative Draft when the system detects there is too much content to add to the notification email. Should this situation occur the system will truncate the data added to the email.
24949086	The Product API now returns the correct number of matching products according to the filters used.
25033948, 25048086	An error no longer occurs when an active specification linked to a non-active site is set to Superseded.
25077219	An error no longer occurs when exporting the recipe table from a specification.
25245176	An error no longer occurs opening a specification which has a nutrition section requiring a large number of translations.

24680756	An error no longer occurs when attempting to open an audit in edit mode.
