

# Micros Supply Chain myCreations

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**Note:** The rebranding for the latest version of this documentation set is in development as part of post MICROS acquisition activities. References to former MICROS product names may exist throughout the existing documentation set.

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This document highlights the major changes and fixes for Release 1.9.0.8 of Micros Supply Chain myCreations.

## Overview

Micros Supply Chain myCreations is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

The suite is composed of the following applications:

- myLibrary - enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- myProduct - supports the development of products and production specifications.
- myProject - supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- mySupplier - enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

TRUNKONEEIGHT-108	An error occurred when clicking the Manage Batch Jobs option. The system no longer produces an error when there is a batch job in the list that contains a null value. Impact on existing installation: None expected

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-117	<p>Unable to search the Web Service log.</p> <p>The system now includes more details within the MESSAGE field, when importing Product Records, so that it can be searched using the basic List View search facility.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONENINE-20	<p>System text spreadsheets had duplicate entries.</p> <p>The system no longer adds a duplicate entry into a system text spreadsheet during the process of maintaining system text.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-109	<p>Removal of Specs by Supplier and Status List View.</p> <p>The List View is removed as it was not possible to optimize the view sufficiently to deal with large amounts of specifications.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: The List View is longer visible, but any personal views created will remain.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-169	<p>Add Business Category fields to the Product and Site List Views.</p> <p>It is now possible for users to select the Business Categories fields in the Product Record or Sites List Views.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: Users are able to select both Business Category fields (Business Categories and Business Category), if required.</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-113	<p>An error occurred when creating a contact for a site.</p> <p>For a supplier user, the system no longer produces an error when creating a new contact for a site.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-121	<p>The user was able to create Retailer User Roles when creating a Supplier User.</p> <p>When a Retailer User (with the correct authority) attempts to create a Supplier User, the system no longer allows the selection of Retailer User Roles.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-136	<p>Change history was not being recorded correctly for attachments in Supplier records.</p> <p>The change history now correctly records attachments added, or removed, on a Supplier record.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-137 Tesseract Ref 87869	<p>Entries were appearing in the External Recipients selector when nothing had been set in the Associated To field.</p> <p>When an email template is being amended, the system no longer displays any entries in the External Recipients selector when nothing has been set in the Associated To field.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-140 Tesseract Ref 89983	<p>Scores did not update when completing an Audit.</p> <p>The system now updates the score within the Audit when the score is set in the Complete Audit and schedule next one dialogue.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-150	<p>Ability to upload additional supplier fields.</p> <p>The system now allows additional fields to be uploaded for migration purposes.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-154	<p>The Supplier and Site contact pages showed the list of roles with commas.</p> <p>The list of contact roles shown against a user on the Contacts page of a Supplier or Site record now shows each one on a separate row as opposed to them being shown one after another with a comma separating them.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: Users viewing the contacts page of the Supplier or Site record now see that contacts that have more than one Contact Role are shown on separate rows as opposed to being one long comma separated list.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-177	<p>A Supplier Administrator user could not create supplier users.</p> <p>The system now allows Supplier Administrators to create supplier users.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-118	Issues with the same reference not appearing in the Issue tab of a Visit. The tab listing issues no longer omits issues which have the same reference number. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-139	A user could not reject an Audit back to IN PROGRESS. The system now allows a Retailer User to reject an Audit from AWAITING SIGN OFF to IN PROGRESS. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-180	Certification Bodies were not appearing in alphabetical order. The system now displays Certification Bodies in alphabetical order when a user is selecting one from a list. Impact on existing installation: None expected

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-123 Tesseract Ref 91372	Mandatory document were not appearing in the Task App for Supplier users. The Task App now correctly shows mandatory documents that are applicable to suppliers. Impact on existing installation: None expected

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-69	Exclusions defined within an Allergen were still flagged as errors in a specification. The system now deals with special characters in both the default and other languages in order to allow the exclusion to be found. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-70	An error occurred when uploading Product Records. Errors no longer occur when uploading products records when a field is missing. Impact on existing installation: None expected

TRUNKONEEIGHT-94	<p>Inactive Surveillance Disciplines were found when copying Produce specifications.</p> <p>Produce Specifications no longer list inactive Surveillance Disciplines when a new version is created or has been copied.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-119 Tesseract Ref 91615	<p>The front of the Pack Copy Nutrition Declaration was incomplete.</p> <p>The Per 100 / serving values now correctly appear in the front of the Pack Nutrition declaration when there is a less than or greater than value as well as a number.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-128	<p>When creating new versions of Specifications, attachments were missing.</p> <p>Attachments are now being copied across when a new version of a specification is created, where the option to copy across attachments has been selected.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-143	<p>Optional Nutrients were not ordered correctly.</p> <p>The system now correctly orders nutrients that are optional within the nutrition section of a specification.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-144	<p>A validation error was encountered with Benchmark Brands.</p> <p>The system now correctly deals with reporting Benchmark Brand validation errors as warnings and not errors.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-148	<p>The Countries Where Sold field in the Product Record allowed the selection of inactive keywords.</p> <p>The system no longer shows inactive keywords in the selector.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: This field is only visible in the Product Record if the <i>Product Record Controls Countries Field</i> parameter has been set to On.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-149 Tesseract Ref 89698	<p>Blank lines appeared in the Pack Copy for Allergy &amp; Dietary declarations.</p> <p>The system no longer omits lines in the Pack Copy with any entries starting at the top of the table.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-151	<p>Not all active nutrient targets were visible when selecting Categories.</p> <p>All active nutrient targets are now visible when selecting Categories in the Nutrition section of a specification.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: This is only applicable if <i>Are Nutrient Targets Used?</i> is set.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-155	<p>A literal was missing in the FNF Additional Product Information Page.</p> <p>A literal is provided for this field.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: Portal Owners operating in more than one language may want to consider adding translations for this system text item.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-159 Tesseract Ref 92121	<p>An error occurred when opening a Specification with certain attachments.</p> <p>An error no longer occurs when an attachment, using the CMYK color scheme, is being attached to a record.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-172	<p>The System Parameter to control Lead Business Category should also apply to the Produce Spec and Produce Product Record.</p> <p>A parameter called <i>Show Lead Business Category in Product Record</i> now controls if the Business Category field is to be split into two or not.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: For Portal Owners using Produce specifications, where this parameter is set to NO, all current and future Produce Specifications will show only one Business Category field.</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-45	<p>An error occurred when adding a column to the Activity Template list view.</p> <p>An error no longer occurs when a user selects to add the Owner column to the Activity Template List View.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-115	<p>Teams within activities were being populated inconsistently.</p> <p>The users shown within an activities team should now always be correct.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-116	<p>The Hierarchy view collapsed every time an activity was clicked.</p> <p>The view no longer collapses when an activity is selected.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-120	<p>The Available to Suppliers flag was visible on the Attachments Manager.</p> <p>The Attachment Manager no longer displays the Available to Suppliers field to suppliers. Supplier users will also not be able to see attachments that have been set to not be visible to suppliers.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-126 Tesseract Ref 91465	<p>An error occurred when scheduling a project that had been un-docked from the main window.</p> <p>The system can now deal with a project that is scheduled when it has been un-docked.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-133	<p>Completed activities disappeared from the Activities page of a Project when completing them.</p> <p>The system now shows completed activities in the Activities page of a Project.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-135 Tesseract Ref 92068	<p>Quick Search did not work on the Project Title.</p> <p>The system now searches the Project Title when using the quick search facility from the myProject / Activities option.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: An update script will be run during the release to assign the correct reference to allow the search to work.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-152	<p>The System Administrator had no access to some myProject views.</p> <p>System Administrators are now able to see a List View called Projects (All) when they are in the Projects view.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: Users with the System Administrator User Role are able to see the new List View.</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-153	<p>The business category was not being updated when adopting the parent information in myProject.</p> <p>The system now refreshes the page when the action to ADOPT PARENT INFORMATION is selected so that it now correctly shows that the business category field has been brought through from the parent project.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-156	<p>The list of users within the teams was not correctly aligned with their respective roles.</p> <p>The Team table, shown on an activity, now aligns the users against the correct User Roles.</p> <p>Impact on existing installation: None expected</p>

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-157	An error occurred when removing an activity from a Project. An error no longer occurs when deleting an activity from a project. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-173	An error occurred when clicking a link in the Project Links page of a specification. The system no longer displays an error when a supplier user clicks a link shown in the Project Links page of one of their specifications. Impact on existing installation: None expected

**Table 8 myArtwork Fixed Issues**

<b>Defect Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
TRUNKONEEIGHT-112	OPAL myArtwork was returning error messages. The system no longer sends chunked messages to OPAL as it cannot deal with them. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-130	Message information was missing for myArtwork messages. The system now provides more information within the Message column of the Web Service Log for the myArtwork service. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-131	User Single Sign-on service was not working. The system now triggers the Single Sign-on service to myArtwork. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-132	Create User Service was not working. The system now triggers a create user service to myArtwork when creating users in myCreations that have been assigned the myArtwork authority profile. Impact on existing installation: None expected
TRUNKONEEIGHT-134	A link to myArtwork was missing. A link to myArtwork is added to the Global tab of the Admin Parameters area. Impact on existing installation: This is only applicable to portals that use myArtwork.

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
