Defects Fixed in This Release

These issues are resolved:

- 1799703 The action list does not refresh when you scroll to the top of the page and pull down.
- 17803853 iOS: If you select multiple filter values, the first filter may not be retained.
- 17996687 In a Planning application, annotations on the History tab may contain HTML tags.
- 17817783 Configured Financial Management applications that you later delete may remain listed on the applications page.
- 17824706 A progress bar doesn't display to indicate that the configuration process is underway.
- 17949251 If you tap "Forget this application" on the Settings page, you are not prompted to confirm that you want to remove the application from the client.
- 18051311 For Planning applications on iPhones: Pages are not updated to indicate if frozen planning units were unfrozen by another user.

General Issues

- 18292397 iOS 7: Filter values that you select may not be retained after you tap Refresh Filter Values.
- 19571513 iPhone 4 with iOS 6.1.3: Not all links display in the product tour or on the main launch page.
- 19560580 Android 4: There isn't a delete button in the search.
- 19298452 Android 4: Due to router activity, the start screen may take several seconds to display after sign off and then sign back in

- 19436387, 19456859 iOS7: There are no buttons that allow you to leave the End User License Agreement (EULA) page if you do not agree to the EULA terms.
- 19422982, 19636664 After closing errors that display if you access an application to which you are not provisioned, a blank screen displays and you must sign out and then sign back in to access an application to which you are provisioned.

Product-Specific Issues

- 18550161 Financial Management: Although you should not be able to, you can, from multiple devices, take action on a published process unit.
- 18549662 Financial Management and iOS7: If multiple users perform actions in the same application from different mobile devices, the Actions page may be blank or display zerovalues.
- 17997037 Planning: You are not returned to the location of a list item that you select. For example, if you select a planning unit at the bottom of a list, you are placed at the top of the list when the page refreshes.
- 18318152 iPhone 4S with iOS 7.0.6: You may be unable to scroll as expected after selecting filters in an Financial Management application.
- 17824706 iPhone with iOS 6 or 7: The icon that indicates that data is loading displays intermittently; appearing and then disappearing.

Locale Issues

- 18526873 Oracle Hyperion Financial Management and Oracle Hyperion Planning: Detail
 pages are blank and do not display history, promotional path, or pass/fail status information
 on a Turkish locale.
- 18526805 Arabic locale users may be unable to navigate the springboard to the left as expected or access the help.
- 19984168 iPhone 4 with iOS7: There are display overlap issues on an Arabic locale.
