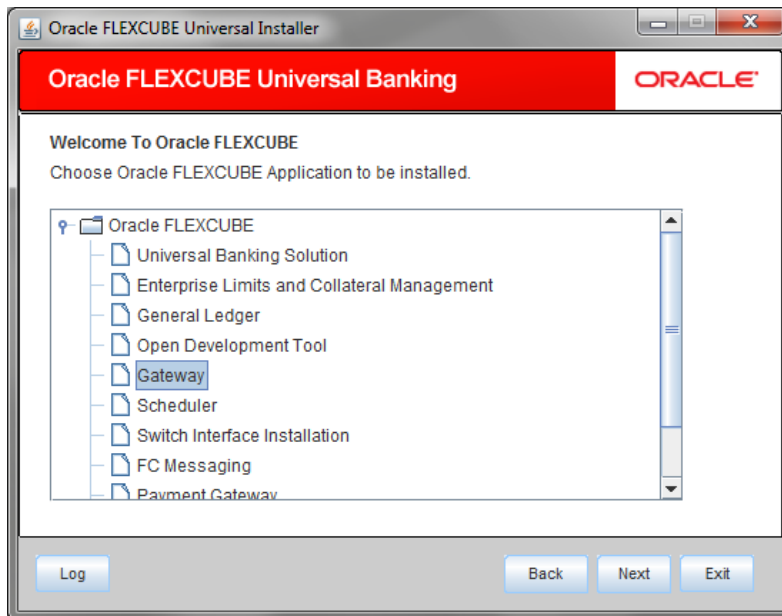
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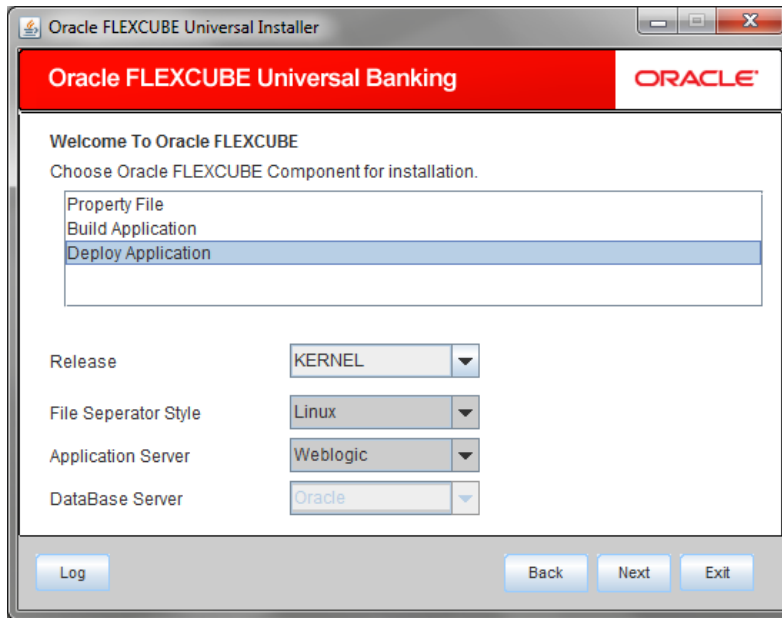
1. Gateway Application Full Deployment

Select the server's operating system in which you are installing the FCUBS application. Select the appropriate one from the adjoining drop-down list.

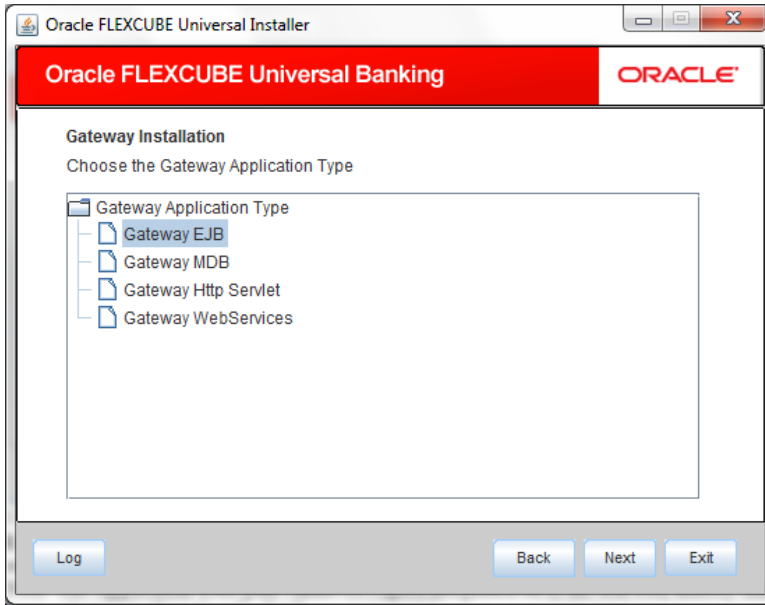

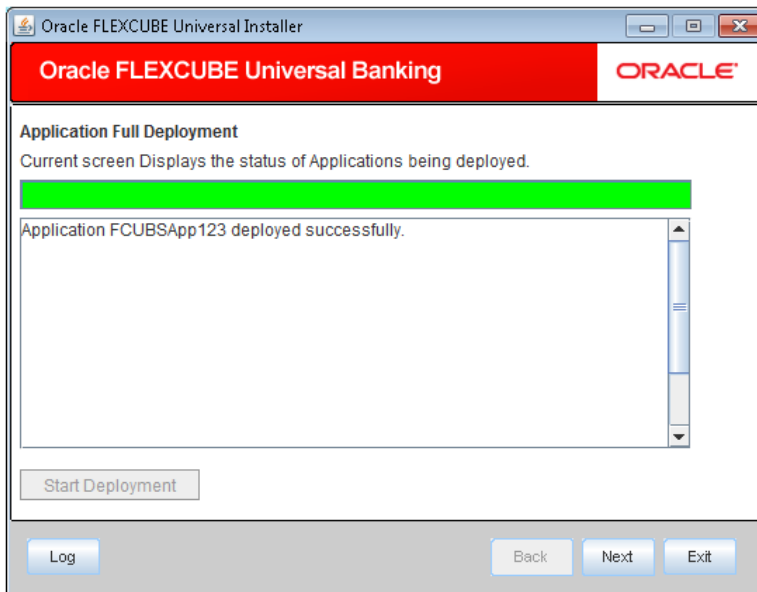
