2 Features and Updates

Password Encryption Tool Packaged with Installation (8.30.8)

The MCweb Password Encryption tool (`EncryptPassword.exe`) is now installed with the Materials Control application in the root application folder. *Oracle Hospitality Materials Control MCweb Password Encryption* contains more information about configuring and using the tool.

Poland Fiscal Export Job Updates (8.30.8)

The building number and flat number for addresses now accept alphanumeric entries. In the Podmiot1 export file:

- `NrDomu` (building number) now retrieves its information from the **Master Data - Manage Cost Center/Stores - Account/Address - Code** field.
- `NrLokalu` (flat number) now retrieves its information from the **Master Data - Manage Cost Center/Stores - Account/Address - External Name** field.

You no longer need to set up and configure the `CostCenterCustomInteger4` (KOSTST.KSTIntCust4) and `CostCenterCustomInteger5` (KOSTST.KSTIntCust5) keys.

Poland Fiscal Inventory Export (8.30.7)

You can now configure and run the **Fiscal Export – Poland** job to create fiscal inventory data outputs for legal compliance. The *Oracle Hospitality Materials Control Poland Fiscal Inventory Export User Guide* contains configuration instructions and references for the exported data.

3 Installing the Patch

8.30

1. Make sure your Materials Control version is the previous patch version.
2. Download and double-click *Date_MC_Update_version.exe* to start the installation wizard.
3. Click **Next**, and then click **Finish** to complete the installation.
Click **OK** if the installation wizard notifies you that it is stopping and starting the DGService.
4. Start Materials Control, and then perform **Database Update** and **Reorganization**.
