### **Overview**

FRS offers the ability show the value of goods scheduled for delivery/transfer within the load percentage bar within the delivery planning / scheduling suite.

## Configuration

#### **Deliveries**

To switch this feature on set the **SHOW\_RETAIL\_LOAD\_VALUE** to a tick within the **application parameter** routine then click the **update** button.

### Operation

#### **Retail Value Calculation**

The retail value is defined as -

The actual selling price exclusive of taxes scheduled for delivery on the run excluding all services.

Collections will be added to the retail value where applicable.

Inter-location (stock) transfers will be added to the retail value using the current prevailing promotional selling price (including options) of the item using today's (system) date unless the item has marked down or if already sold at a different price.

#### **Screen Examples**

Once switched on FRS will show the retail load value when displaying delivery runs.
