This function is used to enter a future date for non-fiscal receipts.

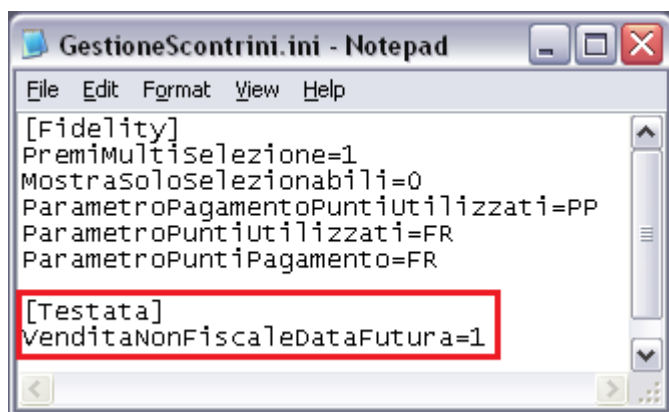
2 Postdated sales management for tests

2.1 Configuration

To enable the new function the new authorization "VenditaNonFiscaleDataFutura" under the "Heading" section needs to be inserted in the ini file "GestioneScontrini.ini". To activate the flag the value "1" needs to be set. Any other value will act as "False".

Example:

```
[Testata]  
VenditaNonFiscaleDataFutura=1
```



2.2 Operation

This necessity is limited to use during a test phase. By enabling the function it will be possible to enter a future date on a heading of a non-fiscal receipt. This way it will be possible to check the functions like promotions without necessarily changing the PC date.
