2.1 Configuration


The “Line discounts for company employees” needs to be enabled in General parameters, Sales section in the Fidelity options.

A new combo box has also been added to the sales section “With employee discount, with line discounts...” to enable with the desired option.



This will be set to “3 Select the most advantageous discount” by default.

2.2 Operation

In receipt management, during a sale registered to a company employee where a discount is included, if the selected product has any type of discount, the program will act based on the deselected option:

- “0 – Calculate the discount on the net”: the employee discount will be calculated on the line value net of price list discounts.
- “1 – Do not calculate the discount”: the price list discount will be maintained and the discount associated with the employee will not be calculated.

- "2 – Replace the discount": the employee discount will be calculated on the gross price of the line and replace the price list discount.
- "3 – Select the most advantageous discount": this is the standard management, the program will evaluate which is the most advantageous discount for the customer and apply it.
