This document highlights the major changes and fixes made for Release 1.10.0.22 of Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service.

## Overview

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

The suite is composed of the following applications:

- myLibrary - enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- myProduct - supports the development of products and production specifications.
- myProject - supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- mySupplier - enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

**Table 1** *General Fixed Issues*

Defect Number	Description
26484557, 26523360, 26551105	<b>Error when making a Global Change</b> A fix is made to rectify an error when using the Change Responsibility global change facility.
27162841	<b>Error when removing external readers from a Library Document</b> A fix is made to rectify an error when removing an external reader from a document.  The issue occurred where the external reader was related to a Site that had previously been deleted.

**Table 2** *mySupplier Fixed Issues*

Defect Number	Description
23476667	<b>Issue adding recipients to an Alert</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue with adding recipients to an alert.  The issue occurred when selecting to add supplier or site recipients to an unsent alert. The selector was not recognizing recipients that had already been selected, resulting in them being cleared. There was also an issue with the deselection of recipients.
26188280	<b>Scope not carried through to a new Audit</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue when a scheduled audit is completed and a new audit is automatically created, where the value of the Scope field was not carried through from the original audit.
26596852	<b>Unable to extract Responses to an Alert</b> A fix is made to rectify an error when extracting the response details for an alert.  The issue occurred if performing the extract while suppliers were still responding to the alert.

**Table 3** *myReports Fixed Issues*

Defect Number	Description
24464281, 26914495, 27304838	<b>Report missing Specify/Species data</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue where the Specify/Species data for Contains and Suitable For questions was missing in a report.
27198326, 27230512	<b>Report has incorrect mapping for Country of Origin</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue with the mapping of fields within reports, where the Country of Origin fields were incorrectly mapped to the Material Function glossary.
27264153, 27281870	<b>Reports not returning expected data</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue where scheduled reports ran, but contained no data.

**Table 3 (Cont.) myReports Fixed Issues**

Defect Number	Description
27284272	<b>Report missing Forced Addition data</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue where Forced Addition data was missing from a product ingredient report.
