This document highlights the major changes and fixes made for Release 1.10.0.24 of Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service.

Note: Release number 1.10.0.23 was skipped.

Overview

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

The suite is composed of the following applications:

- myLibrary - enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- myProduct - supports the development of products and production specifications.
- myProject - supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- mySupplier - enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

Fixed Issues

The following tables list issues fixed in this release:

Table 1 *General Fixed Issue*

Defect Number	Description
26757069, 27429085	Cluster replication issues A fix is made to rectify an issue where updates made on individual servers within a cluster were not being replicated to the other servers within the cluster. The issue specifically related to configuration changes to Allergen Questions, where a change to the description of a question was not being reflected in a new specification if another specification's Allergen section was being edited. The fix ensures that the server cache is cleared whenever changes are made.

Table 2 *myProduct Fixed Issue*

Defect Number	Description
27096818	Issue with row sequencing in Product Standards table of a Produce Specification A fix is made to rectify an issue with the row sequencing within the Defects table of the Product Standards section of a Produce specification. The issue occurred when creating a new version of an approved Produce specification. Changes to the order of rows in the Defects table were not being reflected when viewing the specification in read mode.

Table 3 *myProject Fixed Issues*

Defect Number	Description
27491976	Error when opening the Project Hierarchy views A fix is made to rectify an error when opening the Project Hierarchy views. The error occurred due to the Activity Sub Status description not being initialized. It is now correctly initialized in both the Project Hierarchy and the Project Hierarchy All views.
27546978	Issues with synchronization of Projects with myArtwork A fix is made to rectify an issue with the synchronization of Projects with myArtwork. The change increases the number of retries for the synchronization batch job, and the length of the wait between retries. The retry values have been made back-end system parameters, allowing them to be changed without the need for a code change.

Table 4 *mySupplier Fixed Issue*

Defect Number	Description
27182041	Additional logging during Site maintenance Extra logging has been added to the creation, saving, and deletion of Site records, to provide additional information in the event of issues occurring during the maintenance of Sites.
