This document highlights the fixes made for Release 15.0.4.1 of Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service.

## Overview

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is composed of the following applications:

- Library enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- Product supports the development of products and production specifications.
- Project supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- Supplier enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

## Oracle Retail Cloud Services and Business Agility

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is hosted in the Oracle Retail Cloud with the security features inherent to Oracle technology and a robust data center classification, providing significant uptime. The Oracle Cloud team is responsible for installing, monitoring, patching, and upgrading retail software.

Included in the service is continuous technical support, access to software feature enhancements, hardware upgrades, and disaster recovery. The Cloud Service model helps to free customer IT resources from the need to perform these tasks, giving retailers greater business agility to respond to changing technologies and to perform more value-added tasks focused on business processes and innovation.

Oracle Retail Software Cloud Service is acquired exclusively through a subscription service (SaaS) model. This shifts funding from a capital investment in software to an operational expense. Subscription-based pricing for retail applications offers flexibility and cost effectiveness.

**Table 1 Product Fixed Issues**

Defect Number	Description
25422565, 26244844	<b>Error when editing the product sources in a Produce Specification</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue when editing the product source details in Produce Specifications that have many ingredients.
26240719	<b>Increase of Nutrient Targets numeric field size</b> The Target Value field in the Nutrient Target Categories glossary has the number of integers further increased from 4 to 10, making the maximum size 9,999,999,999.999. Entering a value with more significant digits or decimal places than allowed will result in the number being truncated or rounded respectively.

**Table 2 Supplier Fixed Issues**

Defect Number	Description
25967040	<b>Error when editing the response time in an Alert</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue when setting the response time of an Alert for certain language locales. The error occurred where the user's locale was one with a time format of anything other than the 24-hour HH:mm format, such as to include the AM/PM indicator. The language locales affected are Chilean (Spanish), Central America (Costa Rica, Spanish), and Mexican (Spanish).
26143355	<b>Error when saving a new Audit Checklist</b> A fix is made to rectify an error condition when saving a new Audit Checklist.

**Table 3 Project Fixed Issues**

Defect Number	Description
25874067	<b>Cancelled Projects being automatically reactivated</b> A fix is made to prevent cancelled Projects being reactivated if a linked Activity is completed. Where a cancelled Project has a linked Activity, such as a Product Specification, if the Activity is subsequently completed, the Project's status will no longer be automatically set back to In Progress. It will remain as Cancelled.
25967427	<b>Unable to delete Activities</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue where, if using certain languages, it was not possible to remove an Activity from a Project. An Activity can only be removed when it is has a status of Not Started. The system now correctly uses the status code (which does not vary by language) to check the status, rather than the translatable status description; thus the eligible activities will be capable of being deleted.
26197469	<b>Incorrect dates in Activities</b> A fix is made to rectify an issue where, if using certain languages, the list of Project Activities did not recognize when an Activity was completed, so was showing the planned start and end dates, rather than the actual dates. A Project's list of its Activities contains start and end date columns which initially show the planned start and end dates. The system now correctly uses the status code (which does not vary by language) to check the status, rather than the translatable status description; thus the actual dates will show instead of the planned dates for completed Activities.
