This document highlights the major changes for Release 16.0.4.11 of Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service.

Overview

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is an integrated suite of applications designed to meet all aspects of sourcing, developing, and protecting retailer brands. The suite provides solutions for product development, compliance, quality, and traceability. It is designed specifically for retail, food service, and manufacturing businesses to develop and protect their brands, manage their suppliers, and ensure full end-to-end product lifecycle management.

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is composed of the following applications:

- Library enables the issue, receipt, and acceptance of policies, guidelines, and key working documents.
- Product supports the development of products and production specifications.
- Project supports the development of project briefs, plans, and workflow management.
- Supplier enables the identification, selection, and approval of suppliers.

Oracle Retail Cloud Services and Business Agility

Oracle Retail Brand Compliance Management Cloud Service is hosted in the Oracle Retail Cloud with the security features inherent to Oracle technology and a robust data center classification, providing significant uptime. The Oracle Cloud team is responsible for installing, monitoring, patching, and upgrading retail software.

Included in the service is continuous technical support, access to software feature enhancements, hardware upgrades, and disaster recovery. The Cloud Service model helps to free customer IT resources from the need to perform these tasks, giving retailers greater business agility to respond to changing technologies and to perform more value-added tasks focused on business processes and innovation.

Oracle Retail Software Cloud Service is acquired exclusively through a subscription service (SaaS) model. This shifts funding from a capital investment in software to an operational expense. Subscription-based pricing for retail applications offers flexibility and cost effectiveness.

Fixed Issues

The following tables list issues fixed in this release:

Table 1 General Fixed Issues

Defect Number	Description
26737347	Error when exporting System Text A fix is made to rectify an error when using the System Text export option. The error occurred if the system only had one language active.
27152794	Email failing to send A fix is made to rectify an issue where an Alert email that was automatically generated by the system failed to send to the recipients. The issue was due to there being approximately 2000 recipients, which exceeded the SMTP email message header limit. The fix involves writing the recipients to the BCC field instead of the To field if there are multiple recipients.
27303121	System Text changes not reflected across the system A fix is made to rectify an issue where changes to System Text were not being reflected across the system. The issue was related to the replication of data across servers within a clustered environment.
27348053	Mandatory Field changes not reflected across the system A fix is made to rectify an issue where changes to the Mandatory Fields rules were not being reflected across the system. The issue was related to the replication of data across servers within a clustered environment.
27356738	File Attachment Improvement A change is made to ensure that the local file store usage of any attachments loaded, for purposes of virus scanning, is now cleansed immediately following the successful virus scan process completion.

Defect Number	Description
26908787	<p>Site Code Allocation system parameters not editable</p> <p>A fix is made to rectify an issue where the system parameters for controlling the allocation of site codes when new Sites are created were not editable to the administrator.</p> <p>The Site Code Allocation and Code Editable system parameters are now editable by Power Administrator users, even if sites have already been created.</p> <p>Note: If the Site Code Allocation radio button has Auto selected, the Code Editable check box is automatically unchecked and cannot be checked. The Site Code Format, Prefix Site Code with Supplier User Code, Site Code Unique Across the Portal, and Minimum Site Code Length parameters should not be editable after the first Site has been created.</p>

26286568, 26616531, 27130698, 27136638, 27157238, 27281352, 27281835, 27303189, 27321685	<p>Error when saving a Specification's Nutrition section</p> <p>A fix is made to rectify an error when saving a specification's Nutrition section.</p> <p>The error occurred when a Nutrition Panel had not been selected.</p>

Defect Number	Description
24747596	<p>Error when opening an Activity's Attachment</p> <p>A fix is made to rectify an error when opening an attachment to a Project Activity.</p>
27204577, 27238762, 27264768, 27264773, 27355191	<p>Error when opening Project Hierarchy All view</p> <p>A fix is made to rectify an error when opening the Project Hierarchy All list view.</p> <p>The error occurred when the system was configured to not restrict access by Area (the Enhanced Access Control feature).</p>
