### **New Features**

## New Look and Feel to Visual Insights (VI) Module

There is an updated look-and-feel that modernizes the appearance of Visual Insights to provide an improved user experience.

- Dynamic Links you can create dynamic links to external content in a Grid visualization. For details, in the XBRi online help, see Dynamic links in a Grid visualization.
- Combine Dashboards You can now import multiple dashboards or reports to a dashboard as new sheets, while retaining the original formatting. This feature allows you to quickly and easily share dashboards and reports. For steps, in the XBRi online help, see Importing multiple dashboards or reports into a dashboard.
- Graph Value Options you can now specify values outside the minimum and maximum value range to maintain a consistent scale over time, even if the data is republished and the minimum and maximum values change. For more information, see the Axis Scale's Custom option under Data Exploration options.

### **Attribute Thresholds**

You can add thresholds to attributes in visualizations, allowing you to apply conditional formatting across headers. When applying a threshold to a parent attribute, the conditional formatting is applied at level of the visualization. For details, in the XBRi online help, see Adding or removing a threshold in a visualization for dashboards.

#### **Document Enhancements**

 HTML5 widgets in documents now have a preference menu for the Heat Map and Network widgets, which allows you to further customize widgets within documents. For details, in the XBRi online help, see Providing analysis and interactivity: Widgets.

You must run subscriptions again to re-populate the history lists.</li> <li>When you upgrade from XBRi 10.8.1 to 10.8.2, all existing Alerts are deleted therefore, if you attempt to open an Alert from the Alerts page, the alert will not run. You must run subscriptions again to re-populate the Alerts page.</li> <li>XBRi 10.8.2 does not support File and Printer subscriptions. It is recommended that users unsubscribe from File and Printer Subscriptions prior to upgrading.</li> </ul>
