1 Introduction

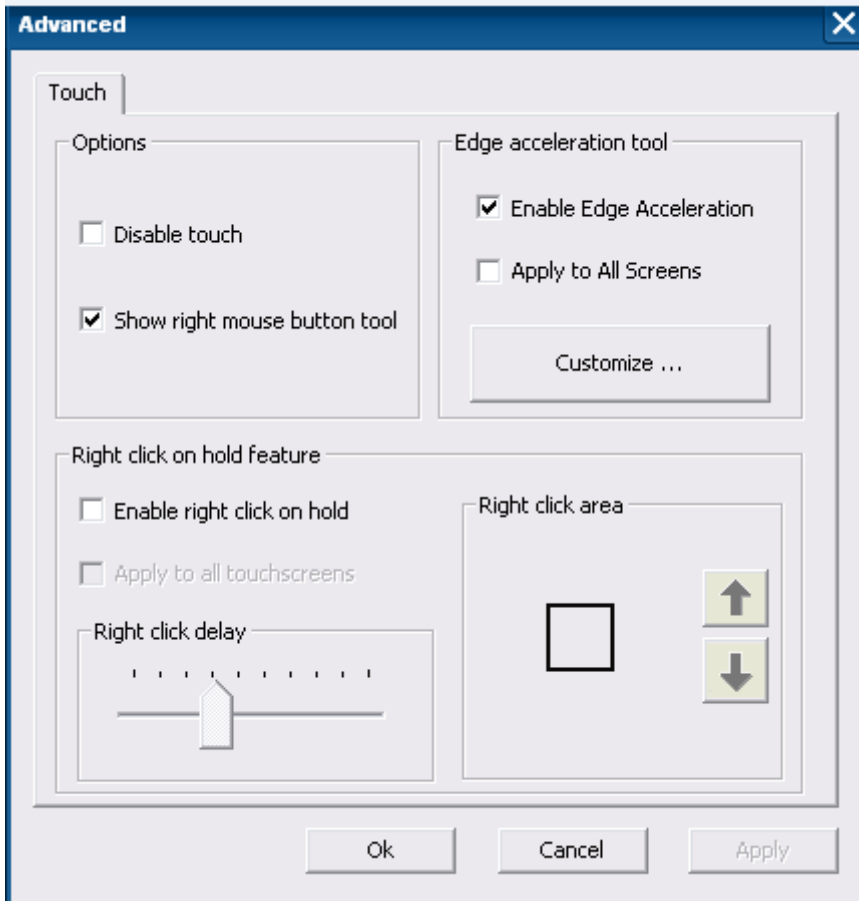
Bellavita is compatible with MICROS Touchscreen devices running Windows XP or Windows 7 operating systems (for example: MICROS WS5), if the required settings are configured accordingly. Please take note that Bellavita can fully operate with MICROS Touchscreen, however it functions more effectively when using MICROS with a mouse attached to it.

2 Settings

The following settings need to be configured in MICROS for BellaVita to operate appropriately.

Settings -> Control Panel -> ELO Touchscreen ->

Properties 1 tab -> Advanced tab:



Ensure that the following functions are active:

- 1, Options > Show right mouse button tool
- 2, Edge acceleration tool > Enable Edge Acceleration

Ensure that the following functions are inactive:

- 1, Options > Disable touch
- 2, Edge acceleration tool > Apply to all screens
- 3, Right click on hold feature > Enable right click on hold

3 Mouse click functionalities on touchscreen

One simple touch on the required field will work as a left click with a mouse. BellaVita however has multiple right-click functionalities which will work as follows:

- On the top left corner on the screen a mouse icon will always be visible. The default view will show that the mouse is on left-click function:



- Touching the icon once will change the mouse to the right-click functionality, but for one click only. After one click the mouse will automatically change back to left-click view.
