#### Added Combo Prices to Menu Item Price Wizard

With this release, the ability to update Combo Meal prices has been added to the Menu Item Price Wizard. Combo Meal prices can now be updated thru the wizard or exported and imported.



Note

After performing a function in the Menu Item Price Wizard you must close the form and re-open it again to perform the next desired function. For example, after updating Menu Item Prices, close the Bulk Menu Item Price Wizard form. Then re-open the form to Update Combo Meals.

Combo Meal prices have also been added to the cmd line import. A new switch was added [–CB]. If –CB is present, operations will apply to combo meal prices.

### Example cmd line:

MiPriceWiz -UID 99 -PWD TESTER -PATH "D:\Temp\Price Imports\" -CB

#### What's Enhanced

An enhancement is defined as a change made to improve or extend the functionality of the current EM application. To qualify as an enhancement, the change must satisfy the following criteria:

- The basic feature or functionality already exists in the previous release of the software.
- The change adds to or extends the current process. This differs from a revision (i.e., a bug fix) which corrects a problem not caught in the previous release of the software.

# Revisions Detailed

# **EM Configurator**

All Menu Items View Sort Order Should Sort by Number

CR ID#: 34199 SCR ID #: 40145

In RES v4.11 in EMCC | 'Navigate View' | ALL MENU ITEMS, All Menu Items defaulted to sort 'By Name'. In versions of EM prior to 4.10, all menu items have always defaulted to sort 'By Number'.

In addition, 'Sort Menu Item Prices by...' changed to 'Effective From (Asc)'; the default should be 'Effective From (Desc)'.

The following have been corrected:

- 1. Sort by number as default sorting for menu items, combo meals, etc.
- 2. For menu item prices, sort the price by effective date at descending order: "Effective From (Desc)".

### Cannot Merge Nodes with New Version in 5.x

CR ID#: 34239/34251 SCR ID #: 40152/40155

As of EM v5.0, some of the features in the EMCC are no longer available or work differently. This is because the EMCC uses a third party component that are not available with some features, or changed with .NET 3.5.

 Adding a new version of a menu item, the ability to merge the nodes is no longer available.

#### Workaround

Instead of using drag and drop to merge properties, use copy and paste. Ctrl+C / Ctrl+V do not work at first. Open the popup menu (right-click) once, and then use Ctrl+C / Ctrl+V.
