Review Patch Documentation

When you install the application for the first time, you install either a base release (for example, 4.0) or a later patch release (for example, Maintenance Release 3). If you are installing the base release or additional patch releases, read the documentation for all releases that have occurred since the base release before you begin installation.

Documentation for patch releases can contain critical information related to the base release, as well as information about code changes since the base release.

Installation and Upgrade

Agreeing to the license terms

After upgrading to MICROS e7 4.0 MR1, the system begins a seven-day grace period. Every time an employee logs in to MICROS e7, it shows an error message warning you that the software is not licensed.

To license MICROS e7 and remove this error message:

1. Log in to the Configurator.
2. Navigate to **PC** from the menu, select **Agree to license terms**, and click **Save**.
3. Navigate to **Workstations** from the menu, select **Agree to license terms**, and click **Save**.
