The functionality is only available with an active **sub license** of **Back Office Interface**.

Introduction

The interface to the TravelClick Demand Business Intelligence system consist of a daily data extract. This data includes property information, reservation, group block and audit data.

The implementation of the Demand 360 data should include the extraction of reservation/ stay and group block data for at least the prior 13 months of historical departure dates and a 365 day period of future demand.

Configuration of the Property Data.

The data extracts needs some specific information in order to identify the property. This information is used in all of the 3 data extracts. Some keys are taken from the existing global settings (Generic 1).

All the other keys need to be configured in the General Hotel info tab of the global settings. Make sure all keys are present with the exact spelling, if not the export will fail to be validated by TravelClick.

Following is the table with the keys and their description. You can check with your travel click representative the values for the keys for your property.

TCDEMAND_PROP_STATUS	Property Status: Possible values: O=Open, C=Closed, R=Under Renovation, P=Pre-Open.



2 Configuration of the data extract

The actual data extract needs to be configured in **Suite8 > Miscellaneous > Export**.

The export is based on 3 new views which are part of this release.

- V8_EXP_TCDEMAND_PROP_BASE: View is used to export the property data.
- V8_EXP_TCDEMAND_RES_BASE: View used to export the reservation / stay data.
- V8_EXP_TCDEMAND_BLOCK_BASE: View used to export the Group Block data.



Note: The file names must be exactly as specified below. See also the specification of TravelClick






