1 Features and Updates

Spa and Leisure

Import guests during upgrade

- BEV-4301 Enhancement to ensure that all guest records are imported or updated properly during version update.

Guests are now stored in the local guest table instead of using v8live.guest view. These are now imported when upgrading from a lower version of leisure.

Online Booking/Interface

- BEV-4374: Sort order of treatments was not in proper order. The sort order of treatments is now Category, Name, Description.

Leisure Install Shield

- BEV-4377 The Leisure Install Shield has been enhanced. The enhancements include, additional options for installations, for example, new installation with/without database, and upgrade.

Reset Data Function

- BEV-4380 To reset data without deleting the configuration, one can use the batch file dbtruncatelivedata.bat from the deployment folder.

This usually will be done after setup, testing and training to delete all bookings and guest-links from leisure, to be ready to start (go live).

Make sure to have a backup. There is no more safety query before starting the batch

| Modules | ID Clarify/BugDB Number | Description |
|----------------|-------------------------|---|
| Online Booking | BEV-4376 | A booking, which comes from online interface, appears as prepaid although there was no payment done so far. This has been fixed. |
| Schedules | BEV-4382 | Bookings in schedules could not be dragged in time. Sometimes it happened, for example, after a ctrl short-key (e.g. ctrl + 1) was used, the bookings could no longer be dragged in time in the schedules. This has been fixed. |
| Booking State | BEV-4390 | Booking in State "consumed" will not expose the leisure price anymore. This can be overridden by setting the system parameter <code>ch.corix.w4y.bo.booking.Offer.adaptPrices = 2</code> |
