Oracle Retail Category Management is part of the Oracle Retail Predictive Planning Suite. Category Management was developed to address the crucial process of determining four primary merchandising dimensions:

- Categories of merchandise carried within a store
- Space allocated to each category of merchandise
- Assortment of items carried in each category
- Space allocated to each item in each category

Note: The 13.0.4 release of Oracle Retail Category Management is a repackaging of the previous release. It was repackaged to keep the Category Management version number synchronized with the RPAS version.
