Oracle Retail Category Management is part of the Oracle Retail Predictive Planning Suite. Category Management was developed to address the crucial process of determining four primary merchandising dimensions:

- Categories of merchandise carried within a store
- Space allocated to each category of merchandise
- Assortment of items carried in each category
- Space allocated to each item in each category

Note: The previous release of Oracle Retail Category Management was 13.0.4. In order to align the release numbers with the Oracle Retail Enterprise, this release of Category Management is named 13.1.1.

The 13.1.1 release of Category Management is a repackaging of the previous release. There were no changes made to the code.

Although the release number is 13.1.1, this is a full base release of Category Management. It is not a patch release.
