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## What's New

Oracle Archive eXchange Format Explorer 2.0 is a new release rebuilt from the previous utility.

## Archive eXchange Format Explorer Enhancements

### AXF 1.0 Support

AXF release 1.0 is supported in addition to backward compatibility for AXF release 0.9.

### Enhanced Security

The security mechanism for setting the Master Password has been enhanced. The new functionality invalidates any previously set password. Users are required to enter a new password the next time the application is started.

## Requirements

Archive eXchange Format Explorer 2.0 runs on Windows 7, Windows 10, Windows 2008 Server, and Windows 2012 Server.

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**Caution:** All DIVArchive processes and services must be completed and shut down before using Archive eXchange Format Explorer. Failure to shut down DIVArchive before use may cause data corruption or loss.
