The purpose of this Release Notes document and Installation Guide is to correct the Oracle Retail Advanced Inventory Planning Installation Guide for Release 16.0.3.

Documentation Release Only

The Oracle Retail Advanced Inventory Planning (AIP) 16.0.3.5.1 release is a documentation-only release. There is no code associated with this release identifier. AIP 16.0.3 remains the current version of the code.

Note: This Release Notes document summarizes the networking and compatibility requirements stated in the *Oracle Retail Advanced Inventory Planning Installation Guide* for Release 16.0.3.5.1.

Installation Guide Updates

The following are corrections made to the Release 16.0.3.5.1 *Oracle Retail Advanced Inventory Planning Installation Guide*.

- AIP is compatible with the database version Oracle 19c Release 3 (version 19.3) in compatibility mode)
- AIP is compatible with the database server OS certified with the database version Oracle 19c Release 3 (version 19.3) in compatibility mode Enterprise Edition
- Set the Oracle Database Compatible Initialization parameter.

Note: For more details on how to set the Oracle Database Compatible Initialization Parameter, refer the section, *What Is Oracle Database Compatibility?*, in the *Release 19 Oracle Database Upgrade Guide*.

In order to run DB 19c in compatibility mode, the DB admin must set this:

```
ALTER SYSTEM SET COMPATIBLE = '12.2.0' SCOPE=SPFILE;
```
