1. Building Application for Setup

The process of building EAR files includes the following steps:

- Obtain the Fcubs.properties file by generating the GUI Installer which is saved in the required path.
- Run the EAR bat file

To build the application for setup using the Silent Installer, follow the steps given below:

- 1. Maintain the Fcubs.properties file path which is created through GUI Installer unlike EAR may fail if the fcubs property file path is not provided.
- 2. Maintain the Environment Property File by inputting all the fields

- 3. Delete the respective build folders before proceeding to run the bat file.
- Goto \INSTALLER\SOFT path and execute the <Product Name>EarRun bat file for FCUBS EAR build.

For Example: <Product Name>EarRun.bat- PMEarRun.bat (PMEarRun.sh) for Payments, ROFCEarRun.bat (ROFCEarRun.sh) for ROFC and so on.

EAR file will be generated in the mentioned source path. Similarly for all the EAR Build follow the same steps.

- 5. For Gateway EAR, execute <Product Name>GatewayEarRun.bat (<Product Name>GatewayEarRun.sh)
- 6. For EJB, MDB and HTTP gateways change the gateway properties path **GW_PROPERTIES_PATH** inside the env.properties. Run the respective bat files i.e. GWEJBEarRun.bat (GWEJBEarRun.sh), GWMDBEarRun.bat (GWMDBEarRun.sh) and GWHTTPEarRun.bat (GWHTTPEarRun.sh).
