1 Uninstallation of AffairWhere

This section describes the AffairWhere uninstallation process.

1. Open the following location:

C:\Control Panel\All Control Panel Items\Programs and Features

2. Right-click AffairWhere, and then select **Uninstall**. Uninstallation begins immediately.

3. Go to C:\Control Panel\All Control Panel Items\Programs and Features to confirm the AffairWhere was uninstalled successfully. If the system does not have AffairWhere installed, proceed with the next phase.

2 Installing AffairWhere

This section describes the AffairWhere installation process.

Note: Only to be installed on Microsoft Windows 32 bit Machines.

1. Right-click the **AffairWhere 2.2.5.zip** file, and then select **Extract Here**.




Figure 2 - File Extraction

2. Open the **AffairWhere 2.2.5** folder, and then right-click the setup icon. Select **Open/Run as administrator** to install the AffairWhere application.




Figure 3 - AffairWhere Application Installation
