

## Oracle Communications ASAP Cartridge for Nokia VLR

The *ASAP Cartridge for Nokia VLR* is an optional software component that enables ASAP to activate subscriber related services on the Nokia VLR system.

### Supported Services

The *ASAP Cartridge for Nokia VLR* supports the following subscriber related services:

Service	Actions & Description
Subscriber	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create a subscriber in the VLR</li><li>• Removes an existing subscriber from the VLR. The HLR of the subscriber is informed about the removal</li><li>• Retrieves subscribers CAMEL data from the VLR (Visitor Location Register)</li><li>• Retrieves the total number of normal as well as telemetric subscribers from the VLR</li><li>• Retrieves the subscribers data from VLR</li><li>• Retrieves the international mobile station equipment identity (IMEI) of the subscriber from the VLR</li><li>• Retrieves the supplementary services of the subscriber from the VLR</li><li>• Retrieves the operator determined barring (ODB) data of the subscriber from the VLR</li><li>• Retrieves the closed user group (CUG) data of the subscriber from the VLR</li></ul>

## **Cartridge Contents**

The *ASAP Cartridge for Nokia VLR* includes:

- Common Service Description Layer Commands (CSDLs)
- Atomic Service Description Layer Commands (ASDLs)
- Java methods
- Installation scripts
- Sample work orders

This cartridge interfaces with the Nokia VLR using the TCP/IP telnet protocol.
