1 Activating the Activities Dashboard

Requirements/Prerequisites

In order to have access to the Activities Dashboard, one or more of the following license codes and application settings must be active.

License Codes

- OPX_OPCI OPERA Xchange for Open Course Interface add-on license must be
 active in the property in order for the property to schedule golf and spa activities
 through the Activities Dashboard
- OPX_GSTC OPERA Gateway for Guest Connection add-on license must be
 active in the property in order for the property to schedule dinning activities
 through the Activities Dashboard

Note: To activate the Activities Dashboard, only one of the above add-on licenses needs to be enabled.

Application Settings


- EAS Activities > Setting > OPENCOURSE WS USERNAME application setting
 must be configured if the OpenCourse interface is to be used for scheduling
 activities.
- EAS Activities > Setting > OPENCOURSE WS PASSWORD application setting must be configured if OpenCourse interface is to be used for scheduling activities.
- EAS Activities > Setting > OPENCOURSE WS EP application setting must be configured if the OpenCourse interface is to be used for scheduling activities.
- EAS Activities > Setting > GUESTCONNECTION WS EP application setting must be configured if Guest Connection interface is to be used for scheduling activities.

Note: When checking availability for a restaurant table in an OPERA system that uses GUEST CONNECTION, a UserDefinedValues element is sent in all Availability request messages. The UserDefinedValues element contains a valueName attribute of "RESVSOURCE." This RESVSOURCE attribute carries a CharacterValue of "OPERA," which is used by GUESTCONNECTION to identify that the availability request originated from an OPERA Hotel.

Steps to Activate the Activities Dashboard

1. Configure the HTNG Interface for Partner System you will be working with. For details on configuration of an HTNG system, please refer to the following guide: "HTNG Installation Guide".


- 2. Verify the HTNG interface is working properly.
- 3. Go to **Setup > Application Settings > EAS Activities** and configure the EAS Activities settings shown in the screen below.
 - The Default Reservation Type setting is required when either the OPX_GSTC Guest Connection or OPX_OPCI Open Course license is active.
 - The Guest Connection WS EP setting will only be displayed when the OPX_GSTC Guest Connection license is active. In this case, the setting configuration is required.
 - The Opencourse settings will only be displayed when the OPX_OPCI license is active and all must be configured.



Note: The WS EP (web services end point) URL for the GuestConnection and OpenCourse WS EP settings must be provided by the vendor. The OpenCourse WS Password and Username must also be provided by the vendor.


Opening the Activities Dashboard

Once activated, the Activities Dashboard can be opened several ways from within OPERA: Select **F5 > Activity Dashboard**.
