OFS Data Foundation Application Pack Maintenance Release v8.0.9.4.0

This Maintenance Release of the OFS Data Foundation Application Pack includes all enhancements and bug fixes that are done since the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.3.2 release.

NOTE

The schemas or domains for OFSDF are referred to as BFND.

2.1 Pre-installation Requirements

These are the pre-installation requirements for the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 release:

NOTE

Before installing OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0, if Data Management Release v8.0.5.0.0 Application Pack (full installer) is already installed on the system, then execute the following statements in the Atomic schema:

- DROP INDEX DIM DATES CALENDAR DATE;
- DROP INDEX DIM KI GROUP LRI;
- The OFSDF Application Pack Release v8.0.9.4.0 is compatible with the WebLogic v12.2.x and does not support the WebLogic v12.1.3. If the WebLogic version is 12.1.3, upgrade to the WebLogic 12.2.x version.
- Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure (OFSAAI) Application
 Pack v8.0.9.3.0 Maintenance Release patch ID 31656153 (download from My Oracle Support
 (MOS)) plus other prerequisite OFSAAI patches (see the *Pre-installation Requirements* section of
 the Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and
 Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.3.0) must be installed and configured on your machine.
- Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation Application Pack v8.0.9.3.2 One-off Release patch ID 32168535 (download from My Oracle Support (MOS)) must be installed and configured on your machine (see the Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation Application Pack Release Notes 8.0.9.3.2).

NOTE

The erwin files for OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 is available on My Oracle Support (MOS) in patch **32162752**.

• Enable the unlimited cryptographic policy. By default, JCE Policy JAR files are available for the Java versions mentioned in the following link and for later versions:

For the Java versions, where unlimited cryptographic policy is disabled by default, follow these steps:

- **a.** Download the JCE Policy related jar files <code>local_policy.jar</code> and US export policy.jar.
 - For Oracle Java, download the local_policy.jar and US_export_policy.jar files from http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/java/javase/downloads/jce-7-download-432124.html.
 - For IBM Java, download the local_policy.jar and US_export_policy.jar files from https://www14.software.ibm.com/webapp/iwm/web/preLogin.do?source=jcesdk.
- **b.** Copy (or replace) the downloaded JCE Policy related jar files <code>local_policy.jar</code> and <code>US_export_policy.jar</code> to the <code>/jre/lib/security</code> directory of the Java installation directory used for OFSAAI and the web application servers.

2.2 Applying this Maintenance Release

This Maintenance Release patch is applicable only for an RDBMS mode of installation.

2.2.1 Downloading OFS Data Foundation Application Pack

To download and extract the release contents, follow these steps:

NOTE

Enable the unlimited cryptographic policy. By default, JCE Policy JAR files are available for Java.

- 1. Log in to My Oracle Support. In the Patches & Updates tab, search for patch ID 32107412.
- **2.** Download the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 archive file and copy it to your OFSAA server in the **Binary** mode.

NOTE

The archive files are different for different operating systems such as AIX, Solaris, and RHEL or Oracle Linux.

- **3.** Stop all the OFSAAI Services. For more information, see the *Stopping Infrastructure Services* section in the Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0.
- **4.** Log in to My Oracle Support, search for the **33663417** Mandatory Patch in the **Patches & Updates** Tab and download it.

ATTENTION

On the 10th of December 2021, Oracle released Security Alert CVE-2021-44228 in response to the disclosure of a new vulnerability affecting Apache Log4J prior to version 2.15. The application of the **33663417** Mandatory Patch fixes the issue.

For details, see the My Oracle Support Doc ID 2827801.1.

Ensure that you reapply the OFSAAI Mandatory Patch **33663417** whenever you Install or Upgrade the Application, or whenever you apply an Incremental Patch.

- **5.** Log in to the OFSAA Server as a non-root user.
- **6.** Execute the following command:

```
chmod -R 750 $FIC HOME
```

7. Assign the WRITE permission to the files and folders such as commonscripts, EXEWebService, ficapp, ficweb, and ficdb by using the following command:

```
chmod -R 775 *
```

- 8. If you have an Unzip utility, skip to the next step. Download the Unzip utility (OS-specific) unzip_<os>. Z and copy it in the Binary mode to the directory that is included in the PATH variable, in the \$HOME path or directory in which you copied the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 installer.
 - **a.** Extract the unzip installer file using the following command:

```
uncompress unzip_<os>.Z
```

NOTE

If you notice an error message: "uncompress: not found [No such file or directory]" when the package is not installed, contact your UNIX administrator.

b. Give the EXECUTE permission to the file using the following command:

```
chmod 751 OFS BFND 8.0.9.4.0 <OperatingSystem>.zip
```

9. Extract the contents of the OFSDF v8.0.9.4.0 archive file using the following command:

```
unzip_<os> -a <name_of_the_file_to_be_unzipped>
```

NOTE

 Rename or remove the existing OFSAA Application Pack folder from the OFSAA server before extracting the contents from the release archive (.zip).

For example: When this release is extracted from the archive, it creates a folder named OFS_BFND_PACK. Rename or remove any existing folder with the same name, which exists in the path where the release archive is copied.

-a option in this step is mandatory to unzip the archive file.

For example:

```
unzip_aix -a
OFS BFND 8.0.9.4.0 <OperatingSystem>.zip
```

2.2.2 Pre-installation Activities

This section provides pre-installation activities required for the installation of the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 release.

Topic:

Model Upload Parameter

2.2.2.1 Model Upload Parameter

You must upload the configuration file params.conf before triggering the installation. The params.conf file is present in the $OFS_BFND_PACK/OFS_BFND/conf/$ directory.

The following are the input parameters for the params.conf file:

- Model Upload Process
 - The required input value is 0 or 1.
 - 0 is an indication to skip the model upload process.
 - 1 is an indication to trigger the model upload process.
 - If the value is **1**, then select the type of the model for the model upload process:

- O indicates the Released Data Model.
- 1 indicates a Customized Data Model.

If the value is 1, then provide the inputs for the Data Model Name and the Path of the Data Model.

2.2.3 Installing the OFS Data Foundation Application Pack

To install the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 release, follow these steps:

 Assign the EXECUTE permission to the Maintenance Release archive file. Navigate to the./OFS_BFND_PACK directory and execute the following command: chmod 750 OFSAAIUpdate.sh

2. Execute the OFSAAIUpdate.sh file using the following command:

./OFSAAIUpdate.sh

3. If OFSAA is deployed on the Oracle WebLogic Server v12.2.x, install the one-off patch **25343603**. See the ReadMe available with the patch for further instructions on installing the patch.

NOTE

If this one-off patch is already applied as a part of the v8.0.9.0.0 release, this step is not required.

For a list of supported servers for OFSAA v8.0.9.0.0, see the <u>Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Technology Matrix Release 8.0.9.0.0</u>.

Verify if the release is applied successfully by checking the log file generated in the installation folder. You can find the log files in the $/OFS_BFND_PACK/logs$ and $/OFS_BFND_PACK/OFS_BFND/logs$ directories. You can ignore the ORA-00001, ORA-00955, ORA-02260, ORA-01031, and ORA-01430 errors in the log files. For any other errors, contact \underline{My} Oracle Support.

2.2.4 Post-installation Activities

The following sections provide information about the post-installation activities for the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 release.

2.2.4.1 Platform-related Post-installation Activities

After OFSDF Application Pack is successfully installed, to perform the OFSAAI related post-installation activities, follow these steps:

1. Clear the application cache.

2. Navigate to the following directory depending on the configured web application server and delete the following files:

Tomcat:

<Tomcat installation folder>/work/Catalina/localhost/<Application name>/org/apache/jsp

WebLogic:

<Weblogic installation location>/domains/<Domain
name>/servers/<Server name>/tmp/_WL_user/<Application name>/<auto
generated folder>/jsp servlet

Websphere:

<Websphere installation directory>/AppServer/profiles/<Profile
name>/temp/<Node name>/server1/<Application name>/<.war file name>

- **3.** Add umask 0027 in the .profile file of the UNIX account, which manages the webserver to ensure restricted access permissions.
- **4.** Perform any necessary additional configuration mentioned in the *Additional Configurations* section in the <u>Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation Application Pack Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0</u>.
- **5.** Apply the OFSAAI Mandatory Patch **33663417**.

See the Readme that is packaged with the Patch for instructions about installing the Patch.

ATTENTION

On the 10th of December 2021, Oracle released Security Alert CVE-2021-44228 in response to the disclosure of a new vulnerability affecting Apache Log4J prior to version 2.15. The application of the **33663417** Mandatory Patch fixes the issue.

Ensure that you reapply the OFSAAI Mandatory Patch **33663417** whenever you Install or Upgrade the Application, or whenever you apply an Incremental Patch.

- **6.** Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application on the configured web application server. For more information on generating and deploying the EAR or WAR files, see the *Post Installation Configuration* section in the <u>Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation</u>

 <u>Application Pack Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0</u>.
- **7.** After the successful installation of the release, restart all the OFSAAI services. For more information, see the *Start/Stop Infrastructure Services* section in the <u>Oracle Financial Services</u> <u>Data Foundation Application Pack Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0</u>.

2.2.4.2 OFSDF Related Post-installation Activities

This section provides the OFSDF related post-installation procedures for the OFSDF Application Pack v8.0.9.4.0 release.

2.2.4.2.1 Applying Mandatory OFSDF Patch

Apply the OFSDF mandatory one-off patch **32310622** (Download the patch from My Oracle Support). See the ReadMe document attached with the patch for instructions about installing the patch.

2.2.4.2.2 Change Batch ICC Ownership

All the seeded batches in the OFSDF Application Pack are automatically assigned to the SYSADMN user during the installation process. To see batches in the **Batch Maintenance** menu, execute the following queries in the Config schema of the database.

Syntax:

```
begin
AAI_OBJECT_ADMIN.TRANSFER_BATCH_OWNERSHIP ('fromUser','toUser','infodom');
end;
OR
begin
AAI_OBJECT_ADMIN.TRANSFER_BATCH_OWNERSHIP ('fromuser','touser');
end;
```

- fromUser indicates the user who currently owns the batch.
- toUser indicates the user to whom the ownership must be transferred.
- infodom is an optional parameter. If you specify this parameter, the ownership of the batches of that infodom is changed.

For example:

```
begin
AAI_OBJECT_ADMIN.TRANSFER_BATCH_OWNERSHIP
('SYSADMN','FSDFOP','OFSBFNDINFO');
end;
```

2.2.4.2.3 Configuration to Enable the Restatement Support

The Restatement Support feature enables the backdated Run execution for any Start Date and End Date explicitly on a specific list of metadata for data refiling in the OFSDF Application Pack.

NOTE

This section is applicable only for an RDBMS mode of installation.

To enable the Restatement Support feature in the OFSDF Application Pack, see the procedure in the Configurations to Enable the Restatement Support section in the Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation Application Pack Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0.

3.1 Frequently Asked Questions

What checks does the v8.0.9.4.0 release patch perform?

This release patch performs the following checks:

- Environment Check: During the environment check, it performs Java validation, Environment Variables validation, OS-specific validation, DB specific validation, and shuts down all the OFSAAI Services (Infrastructure Server, ICC Server, and back-end services).
- Post-installation check: As a part of the Post-installation check, the patch checks if the OFSAAI services can be successfully started.

Which version of the erwin Data Modeler does OFSAAI support?

OFSAAI now supports the erwin Data Modeler versions 2019 R1 and 2020 R2 generated XMLs.

What should I do for viewing the log files at the Debug level for troubleshooting?

By default, the log level is set as **INFO**. You must manually change the log level to **Debug** to view the log files in the debug level. Based on your requirements, you can also change the log level to Warn, Error, or Fatal. To view log files, follow these steps:

- 1. Navigate to the \$FIC HOME/conf directory in the APP layer of your OFSAAI installation.
 - Change the priority value to Debug in the RevLog4jConfig.xml file.

For example:

```
<root>
<priority value ="debug" />
<appender-ref ref="ConsoleAppender1"/>
</root>
```

 Replace the value of the LOGGERLEVEL parameter in the DynamicServices.xml file from 20 with 0 (20 is the value for Info and 0 for Debug).

NOTE

For a multi-tier installation, also change the LOGGERLEVEL value to 0 (Debug) in the DynamicServices.xml and RevLog4jConfig.xml files, which are present in the \$FIC_APP_HOME/conf, \$FIC_DB_HOME/conf, and \$FIC_WEB_HOME/conf directories.

2. Navigate to the \$FIC_WEB_HOME/webroot/conf directory and change the **priority** value to **Debug** in the ExportLog4jConfig.xml, MDBLogger.xml, and PR2Logger.xml files to view

- the log files at the Debug level for the modules Archive or Restore, Metadata Browser, and RRF, respectively.
- **3.** Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application on the configured web application server. For more information on generating and deploying the EAR or WAR file, see the *Post Installation Configuration* section in the <u>Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0</u>.
- **4.** Restart the OFSAAI Services (APP and WEB). For more information, see the *Start/Stop Infrastructure Services* section in the <u>Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide Release 8.0.9.0.0</u>.
