## 1 OFS REG REP US FED Pack Release 8.0.3.2.0

This Maintenance Level Release (ML) of OFS RRS US FED – Lombard Risk Integration Pack is cumulative and includes all enhancements and bug fixes done since the OFS REG REP US FED – Lombard Integration Pack v8.0.3.1.0 minor release. For more information, refer the Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting for US Federal Reserve – Lombard Risk Integration Pack Guide – Release 8.0.3.2.0 on OTN.

# 1.1 Pre Installation Requirements

The prerequisites are as follows:

- 1. You should have Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Infrastructure (OFSAAI) 8.0.3.1.0
- You should have Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation (FSDF) 8.0.3.1.0
- 3. You should have OFS REG REP US FED 8.0.3.0.0 full installer (Bug 24947981).

**NOTE:** The OFS REG REP US FED 8.0.3.0.0 Full Installer (Bug **24947981**) is mandatory prerequisite for this patch, irrespective of any higher / lower version of OFS\_REG\_REP\_USFED application already installed on the setup.

4. Execute the following command in Atomic Schema to remove duplicates entries in DIM RESULT BUCKET table:

```
DELETE FROM DIM_RESULT_BUCKET WHERE
DIM RESULT BUCKET.V BUCKET TYPE='FRY2052A'
```

**NOTE:** Ensure there is no "**Referential Integrity**" error during the execution of above scripts.

# 1.2 How to Apply This Maintenance Level Release?

## 1.2.1 Installing OFS RRS US FED

Refer to the following instructions to download, extract, and install this IR.

- 1. Login to <a href="https://support.oracle.com/">https://support.oracle.com/</a> and search for 25443064 under the Patches & Updates tab.
- Download the OFS REG REP US FED v8.0.3.2.0 ML archive file and copy it to your OFSAA server in **Binary** mode.
- 3. Shut down all the OFSAA Services. For more information, refer to the *Start/Stop Infrastructure Services* section in <u>Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide Release 8.0.3.1.0.</u>

4. Assign WRITE permission to the files/ folders such as commonscripts, EXEWebService, ficapp, ficweb, and ficdb in the \$FIC HOME folder by executing the command:

```
chmod -R 750 $FIC HOME
```

- 5. If you have Unzip utility, skip to the next step. Download the Unzip utility (OS specific) unzip\_<os>.Z from the location <a href="https://updates.oracle.com/unzips/unzips.html">https://updates.oracle.com/unzips/unzips.html</a> and copy it in Binary mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically \$HOME path or directory in which you have copied the 8.0.3.2.0 ML.
  - Uncompress the unzip installer file using the command:

```
uncompress unzip <os>.Z
```

NOTE: In case you notice an error message "uncompress: not found [No such file or directory]" when the package is not installed, contact your UNIX administrator.

6. Give EXECUTE permission to the file using the command:

```
chmod 751 OFS REG REP USFED 8.0.3.2.0 <OperatingSystem>.zip.
```

7. Extract the contents of the 8.0.3.2.0 ML archive file using the command:

```
unzip <os> -a <name of the file to be unzipped>
```

**NOTE:** The above "-a" option is mandatory to unzip the archive file. For example: unzip\_aix -a OFS\_REG\_REP\_USFED\_8.0.3.2.0\_<OperatingSystem>.zip

- 8. Configure the file Param.conf that is present under OFS REG REP USFED/conf.
- 9. Configure the Model Upload Parameter as: 0 (that is, if you have already performed Model Upload and want to skip model upload process)
  - # Specify whether you want to perform Model Upload
  - # 0 = If you have already performed Model Upload and want to skip model upload process
  - # 1 = If you want to perform Model Upload

UPLOAD\_MODEL=0

10. Navigate to OFS REG REP USFED/bin and execute ./install.sh

Verify if the IR is applied successfully by checking the log files generated in the installation folder under OFS\_REG\_REP\_USFED/logs

- 11. After successful installation of ML, perform these steps:
  - Clear the application cache. Navigate to the following path depending on the configured web application server and delete the files.
    - Tomcat:

<Tomcat installation folder>/work/Catalina/localhost/<Application name>/org/apache/jsp

### WebLogic:

<Weblogic installation location>/domains/<Domain name>/servers/<Server name>/tmp/\_WL\_user/<Application name>/qaelce/jsp\_servlet

## WebSphere:

<Websphere installation directory>/AppServer/profiles/<Profile name>/temp/<Node name>/server1/<Application name>/<.war file name>

- 12. If the Webserver is Tomcat, then copy the jaxrpc.jar file from \$FIC\_HOME/axis-1\_4/webapps/axis/WEB-INF/lib to \$FIC\_WEB\_HOME/webroot/WEB-INF/lib.
- 13. Add umask 0027 in the .profile of the UNIX account which manages the WEB server to ensure restricted access permissions.
- 14. Generate the application EAR/WAR file and redeploy the application onto your configured web application server. For more information on generating and deploying EAR / WAR file, refer to the *Post Installation Configuration* section in <u>Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical</u>

  Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide Release 8.0.3.1.0.
- 15. After the successful installation of the IR, restart all the OFSAA services. For more information, refer to the *Start/Stop Infrastructure Services* section in <u>Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide Release 8.0.3.1.0</u>.

# Appendix A

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

## What checks does the 8.0.3.2.0 Release patch perform?

- Environment Check- As part of environment check, it performs Java validation, Environment Variables validation, OS specific validation, DB specific validation, and it shuts down all OFSAAI Services (Infrastructure Server, ICC Server, and back-end services).
- Post Install check- As part of Post install check, it checks if OFSAAI services can be successfully started.

### Which version of ERwin Data Modeler does OFSAAI support?

OFSAAI now supports ERwin version 9.2 and 9.5 generated XMLs in addition to ERwin 4.1, ERwin 7.1, ERwin 7.3 and ERwin 9.0 formats.

## What should I do for viewing the log files in Debug level for troubleshooting?

By default, the log level is set as INFO. You need to manually change to Debug to view the log files in debug level. Based on your requirement, you can change the log level to Warn, Error, or Fatal as well.

- Navigate to \$FIC\_HOME/conf in the APP layer of your OFSAAI installation.
  - Change the **priority value** to **Debug** in the *RevLog4jConfig.xml* file.

#### For example:

```
<root>
  <pri><priority value ="debug" />
  <appender-ref ref="ConsoleAppender1"/>
</root>
```

Change the value of **LOGGERLEVEL** in the *DynamicServices.xml* file from **20** to **0**. (**20** is the value for Info and **0** for Debug.)

**NOTE:** For multi-tier installation, you need to change the log level to Debug in the *DynamicServices.xml* and *RevLog4jConfig.xml* files, which are present in \$FIC\_APP\_HOME/conf, \$FIC\_DB\_HOME/conf, and \$FIC\_WEB\_HOME/conf as well.

Navigate to \$FIC\_WEB\_HOME/webroot/conf and change the priority value to Debug in the
 ExportLog4jConfig.xml, MDBLogger.xml, and PR2Logger.xml files for viewing log files in Debug
 level for the modules Archive/Restore, Metadata Browser and RRF respectively.
