It provides integrating risk data reporting systems and enhances the accuracy of reporting in banks. OFS Risk Regulatory Reporting (REG REP) Solution helps in achieving the objectives by enabling preset steps based on the generalization of a set of solutions. This is made possible by:

- Providing centralized data storage for risk data through relevant subject areas of the Financial Services Data Foundation (FSDF).
- Interfacing with a third-party reporting tool such as Lombard Risk Reporter Portal to build necessary template reports to meet the regulatory expectations.

Data accuracy of risk reporting is ensured by:

Data Governance Studio (DGS).

2 Hardware and Software Requirements and Specifications

This section describes the various operating system, database, web server, and web application server version and other variant details on which this release of the OFS Regulatory Reporting for US Federal Reserve – Lombard Risk Integration Pack (OFS REG REP US FED) application has qualified.

See the OFS Analytical Applications Technology Matrix for Hardware and Software requirements for this release.

3 Preparing for Installation

This Maintenance Level Release of OFS REG REP US FED – Lombard Risk Integration Pack includes all enhancements and bug fixes since the OFS REG REP US FED – Lombard Integration Pack v8.0.9.0.0 release. For more information, see the OFS Regulatory Reporting for US Federal Reserve – Lombard Risk Integration Pack User Guide Release v8.0.9.0.0.

3.1 Obtaining the Software

This release of OFS REG REP US FED v8.0.9.7.0 can be downloaded from My Oracle Support website. Log in and search for **32222146** under the Patches and Updates tab and download the OFS REG REP USFED 8.0.9.7.0 GENERIC.zip archive file.

You must have a valid Oracle account to download the software.

3.2 Prerequisites for Installation

This installer has fresh install capabilities and the following are the minimum prerequisites to install OFS REG REP US FED application:

- Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Infrastructure (OFSAAI) 8.0.9.0.0 (patch 30330054) plus other prerequisite OFSAAI patches (see Section 2.1 Pre-installation Requirements of OFS AAI Installation Guide) should be installed and configured in your Machine (OHC Documentation Library).
- Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation (OFSDF) 8.0.9.4.0 (patch 32107412), 8.0.9.4.1 (patch 32310622) plus other prerequisite OFSDF patches (see Section 2.1 Pre-installation Requirements of OFSDF Installation Guide) should be installed and configured in your Machine (OHC Documentation Library).
- Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting for US Federal Reserve Lombard Risk Integration Pack 8.0.9.0.0 (patch 30557951) or higher.
- AgileREPORTER version 20.3.2-b156.
- AgileREPORTER Templates version AgileREPORTER for FED v1.23.2.1-b27.
- Ensure that you have executed the .profile file before you trigger the installation.
- Ensure that the FICServer is up and running before you trigger the installation. For information on restarting the services, See the <u>OFS Analytical Applications Infrastructure Release 8.0.2.0.0</u> Installation Guide for more information.

3.3 Installing OFS REG REP US FED 8.0.9.7.0 ML

Perform the following instructions to copy, extract, and install this ML patch:

- 1. Copy the downloaded archive file to your OFSAA server in **Binary** mode.
- 2. Shut down all the OFSAA Services. For more information, see the *Stopping Infrastructure Services* section in the OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide Release 8.0.7.0.0.

NOTE

Ensure that the FICSERVER is up and running.

- 3. Execute chmod -R 750 \$FIC HOME
- **4.** If you have an Unzip utility, skip to the next step.

Download the Unzip utility (OS-specific) unzip_<os>.z from the location https://updates.oracle.com/unzips/unzips.html and copy it in Binary mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically \$HOME path or directory in which you have copied the 8.0.9.7.0 ML patch.

• Uncompress the unzip installer file using the command:

uncompress unzip_<os>.Z

NOTE

If you notice an error message: *uncompress: not found [No such file or directory]*, contact your UNIX administrator.

- Execute chmod 751 OFS_REG_REP_USFED_8.0.9.7.0_GENERIC.zip
- 6. Execute unzip -a <name of the file to be unzipped>
 For example: unzip -a OFS_REG_REP_USFED_8.0.9.7.0_GENERIC.zip
- 7. Configure the UPLOAD_MODEL parameter in the param.conf file present under the OFS_REG_REP_USFED/conf directory to determine if Model Upload is required or not:
 - 0 = If you have already performed Model Upload and want to skip the Model Upload process1 = If you want to perform Model Upload
- 8. Navigate to the OFS REG REP USFED/bin directory and execute ./install.sh
- **9.** The installation progress can be viewed by periodically refreshing the log file in the OFS_REG_REP_USFED/logs directory.
- **10.** After installation is completed, verify the log file for any Errors or Warnings. Contact My Oracle Support in case of any issues.

NOTE

This patch installation has taken approximately 10 minutes to complete in Oracle Labs.

3.4 Post-installation Steps

The post-installation steps required for this 8.0.9.7.0 ML release are as follows:

Apply the OFS AAI 33663417 mandatory patch.

ATTENTION

On the 10th of December 2021, Oracle released Security Alert CVE-2021-44228 in response to the disclosure of a new vulnerability affecting Apache Log4J before version 2.15. The application of the **33663417** Mandatory Patch fixes the issue.

For details, see the My Oracle Support Doc ID 2827801.1.

Ensure that you reapply the **33663417** Mandatory Patch whenever you install or upgrade the application or apply an incremental patch.

- See the log file in the **/OFS_REG_REP_USFED/logs** directory to ensure that there are no errors reported.
- After replacing ##INFODOM## with INFODOM name for USFED, ##SEGMENT## with SEGMENT name for USFED, ##PROCESSING## with T2T Source name for USFED processing and #STAGING## with T2T Source name for FSDF processing, execute the USFED 80970 Config Post Script.sql file in the Config Schema.
- Execute the USFED 80970 Atomic Post Script.sql file in the Atomic Schema.
- Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application on the configured Web Application Server. For more information on generating and deploying EAR or WAR file, see the Post Installation Configuration section in the OFSs Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide – Release 8.0.7.0.0.
- Resave the Derived Entity for the reports FFIEC-031, FFIEC-041, FRY-9C and FRY-14M, if you're upgrading from the REG REP USFED v8.0.9.6.3.
- Resave the Derived Entity for the reports FFIEC-031, FFIEC-041, FRY-9C, FRY-14M, FRY-14Q, FRY-15 and FFIEC-009 if you're upgrading from the REG REP USFED v8.0.9.6.0.
- Restart all the OFSAA services. For more information, see the Starting Infrastructure Services section in the OFSA Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide – Release 8.0.7.0.0.
- Perform the Source Model generation for US FED Processing Source. For more information, see
 the Generating Source Models section in the OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure
 Pack Installation Guide Release 8.0.7.0.0.

The Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting for US Federal Reserve – Lombard Risk Integration Pack (OFS REG REP US FED) is now ready for use. If you encounter any problems during set up, contact OFSAA Support at My Oracle Support.

3.5 Post US FED Run Execution

After the US FED Run execution, follow these steps:

- 1. For prior date reporting, see the Prior Date Reporting document.
- 2. Execute the <<INFODOM>>_REG_RUNEXE_RESAVE batch to populate the RUNEXESUMM table if you are not using the FFIEC-002 or FFIEC-002S reports.

If you are using the FFIEC-002 or FFIEC-002S reports, then execute the <Installer Path>/OFS_REG_REP_USFED/Post_Scripts/RUNEXESUMM_VW.sql file in atomic schema.

Lombard AgileREPORTER would display additional filters of Run Execution ID and Run Status during report retrieval based on the RUNEXESUMM table:

a. Run Execution ID is the Run Execution Identifier concatenated with Run Description.

- b. Run Status shows the status of US FED Run Execution.
- **c.** Define the entities as SOLO or CONSOLIDATED in Lombard AgileREPORTER before retrieving returns.
- 3. Execute the REFRESH batches to refresh the Derived Entities.

3.6 Deploying Config Package

This section describes the steps to deploy the config package after saving the derived entities:

- To deploy the product configuration on AgileREPORTER using the package OFSAA_REG_REP_USFED_80970.zip bundled inside Config_Package directory of the installer:
 - a. Navigate to the <LombardAgileREPORTER>/bin directory inside the installed location.
 - **b.** Add a new configuration with the following command:
 - ./config.sh -a <Config_Package Full Path>
 For example:
 ./config.sh -a /scratch/kit/80970/OFS_REG_REP_USFED/
 Config Package/OFSAA REG REP USFED 80970.zip
- 2. Update the Alias with the following command:

```
./config.sh -ea OFSAA_REG_REP_USFED_80970 -iv 8.0.9.7.0 -alias "OFSAA FED DATA SOURCE" -aif /scratch/agile/bin/aliasinfo.properties
```
