2 OFS DM Application Pack Release 8.0.8.3.0

This release of the OFS DM Application Pack includes enhancements and bug fixes done since the OFS DM Application Pack v8.0.8.2.5 release.

2.1 Prerequisites

If you are already using OFS DGS Application, then the minimum patch set level must be OFS DM Application Pack v8.0.8.2.5.

If you want to upgrade the OFS GL Recon application v8.0.8.0.x to v8.0.8.3.0, then execute the pre-install SQL script: [DM8083ML_pre-install_script.sql](#) in the Atomic schema and proceed with the v8.0.8.3.0 Maintenance Release installation.

2.2 Installing this Release

To install this release, follow these steps:

1. Log in to [My Oracle Support](#), and search ID **31972490** under the **Patches and Updates** tab.
2. Download the `31972490_GENERIC.zip` archive file and copy it to your OFSAA server in Binary mode.
3. Shut down all the OFSAAI services. For more information, see the *Stopping Infrastructure Services* section in the [Oracle Financial Services Data Management Pack Installation Guide 8.0.8.0.0](#).
4. Log in to [My Oracle Support](#), search for the **33663417** Mandatory Patch in the **Patches & Updates** Tab and download it.

5. Login to the OFSAA server with the user credentials that were used to install OFS DM.
6. Extract the contents of the patch archive file using the command:

```
unzip -a <name of the file to be extracted>
```

For example, for Linux OS: `unzip -a OFS_DM_8.0.8.3.0_LINUX.zip`

Or

For Solaris OS: `unzip -a OFS_DM_8.0.8.3.0_SOLARIS_SPARC.zip`

Note: The above "-a" option is mandatory to unzip the patch.

If you notice an error message "*unzip: not found [No such file or directory]*" before the package is installed, contact your UNIX administrator.

7. Assign RWX (755) permissions to the folder by executing the following command:

```
chmod -R 755 $FIC_HOME
```

8. If you already have an unzip utility installed, skip to the next step.
If you do not have an unzip utility, download the unzip utility (OS-specific), and copy it in **Binary** mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically **\$HOME** path or the directory in which you have copied the v8.0.8.3.0 ML installer.

- Uncompress the unzip installer file using the following command:

```
uncompress unzip_<os>.z
```

NOTE

If you receive an error message stating: "Uncompress: not found [No such file or directory] and the package is not installed", contact your UNIX administrator.

- Give EXECUTE permission to the file using the following command:

```
chmod 755 OFS_DM_80830_<OS>.zip
```

9. Extract the contents of the OFS DM Application Pack v8.0.8.3.0 in the Download Directory installer archive file using the following command:

```
unzip <name of the file to be unzipped>
```

Modify the `params.conf` file present in the `OFS_DM_PACK/OFS_DM/conf` directory and update the following parameters using the instructions given in the `params.conf` file.

In the `params.conf` file, update the value in the `UPLOAD_MODEL` parameter to 0.

10. Give EXECUTE permission to the installer file. Navigate to the `OFS_DM_PACK/` directory and execute the following command:

```
chmod 755 OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

11. Execute the following software upgrade command:

```
./OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

Verify that the maintenance level release is applied successfully by checking the following log files generated in the installation folder:

- `OFS_DM_PACK/OFS_DM/logs/OFS_DM_patch_installation.log` for the OFS Data Management Application Pack installation log file.

12. You can ignore the following errors in the log files:

- ORA-00001

If there are other errors, contact My Oracle Support.

2.3 Post Installation Configuration

NOTE This section applies to Oracle Financial Services Data Governance for US Regulatory Reporting.

On successful installation of the Oracle Financial Services Data Management Application Pack, follow these post-installation configuration steps.

2.3.1 Patch OFSAA Infrastructure Installation

Oracle strongly recommends installing the latest available patch set to be up-to-date with the various releases of the OFSAA product.

Apply the following mandatory patch:

- 33663417

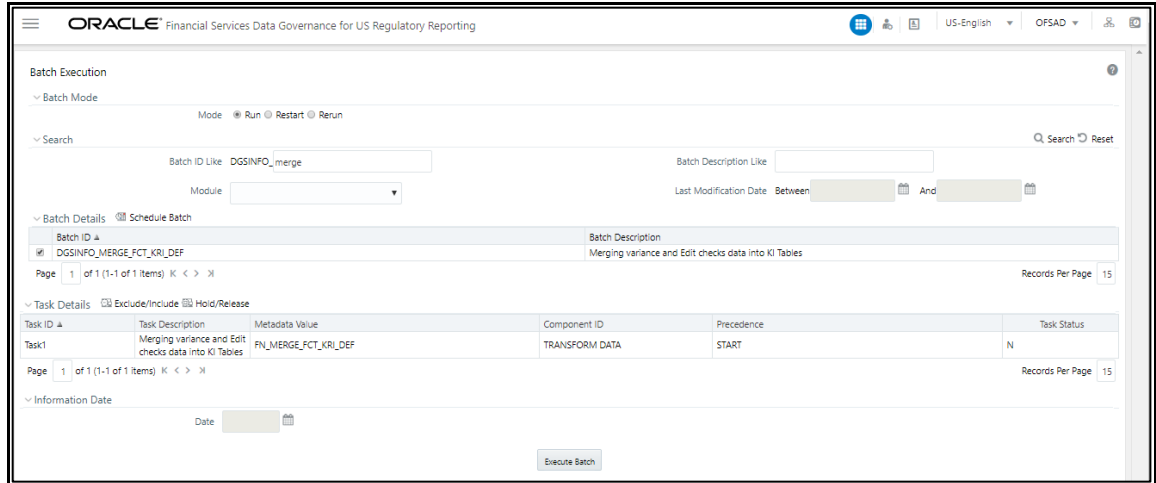

2.3.2 Merging Key Indicators

To merge the Key Indicators, follow these steps:

1. From the **Financial Services Data Foundation** window navigate to **Operations** and select **Batch Execution**.
2. Execute the Batch Name as **MERGE_FCT_KRI_DEF**. This batch is used to merge the variance and edit checks into the Key Indicators.
3. Enter the current system date as the **MISDATE** for this batch.

Figure 1: Batch Execution

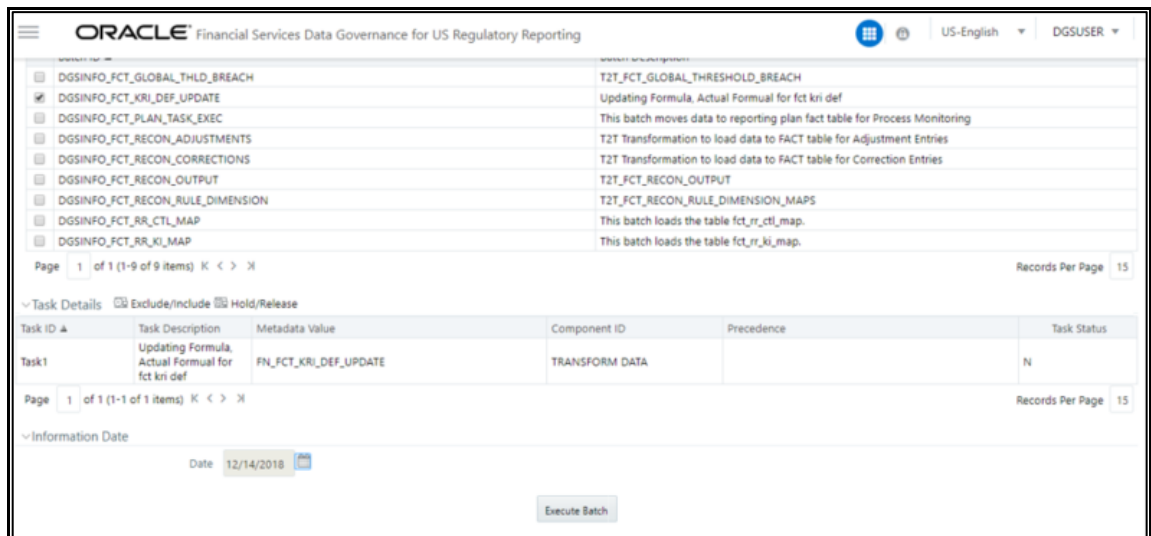


2.3.3 Updating Measures for Key Indicators

To update Measures for Key Indicators, follow these steps:

1. From the **Financial Services Data Foundation** window navigate to **Operations** and select **Batch Execution**.
2. Run the batch **##INFODOM##_FCT_KRI_DEF_UPDATE** on sysdate. This batch is used to update the measure name, map key, and measure key for the Key Indicators available in the system.
3. Enter the current system date as the MISDATE for this batch.

2.3.4 Key Indicator Configuration

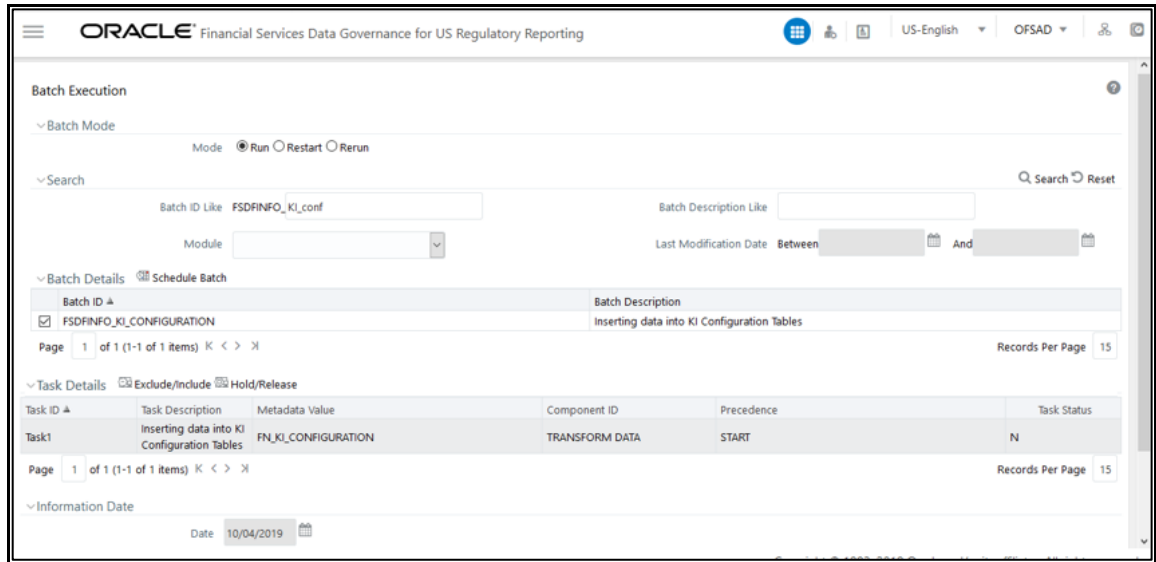
From **Financial Services Data Foundation** window navigate to **Operations** and select **Batch Execution**. Run the batch **##INFODOM##_KI_CONFIGURATION**. This batch is used to update the

Actual Formula for the key indicator. This batch generates the report, schedule, and cells required for Key Indicator assessment configurations.

From the **Financial Services Data Governance for US Regulatory Reporting** window navigate to **Administration** and select **Key Indicator Assessment Configuration**. Here, you can select and configure the report, schedule, and cell combinations.

2.3.5 Performance-Related Configuration Details on Account Mapper Batch

- Parallel Hint for query optimization in KI Mapper can be made configurable by setting up N_LOOKUP_VALUE in FSI_DGS_CONFIGURATION against the following column values(V_MODULE_NAME='MAPPER', V_LOOKUP_CODE='PARALLEL_HINT'). The default value set for parallel hint is /*+ PARALLEL(4)*/.

V_MODULE_NAME	V_LOOKUP_CODE	N_LOOKUP_VALUE	V_LOOKUP_CODE_DESC
MAPPER	PARALLEL_HINT	/*+ PARALLEL(4)*/	Parallel hint for query optimization for KI Mapper.

- Parallel Hint for Gather Stats optimization in KI Mapper can be made configurable by setting up N_LOOKUP_VALUE in FSI_DGS_CONFIGURATION against the following column values(V_MODULE_NAME='MAPPER', V_LOOKUP_CODE='GATHER_STATS_PARALLEL_HINT'). The default value set for the parallel hint is 8.

V_MODULE_NAME	V_LOOKUP_CODE	N_LOOKUP_VALUE	V_LOOKUP_CODE_DESC
MAPPER	GATHER_STATS_PARALLEL_HINT	8	Parallel hint for Gather Stats optimization for KI Mapper

2.3.6 OBIEE Configuration and Deployments

The following OBIEE configuration files must be updated to change the user's preferred currency:

1. Login to the OBIEE Server.
2. Edit the `/Oracle_Home/bi/bifoundation/web/display/currencies.xml` file.
3. Update `"symbol="$"` to change the preferred currency as follows:

```
<Currency tag="int:wrhs" type="international" placeholder="true"
symbol="$" format="$#" digits="2"
displayMessage="kmsgCurrencySiebelWarehouse">
  <negative tag="minus" format="-$#" />
</Currency>
```
4. Copy the `DGS.catalog` and `DGS.rpd` files from the `<FIC_HOME>/DGSBI` directory to your local machine and redeploy the `DGS.catalog` and `DGS.rpd` files.

2.3.7 Run Chart for Batch Executions

NOTE

When re-running a scenario of the Account Mapper Insert Batch (##INFODOM##_ACCT_MAPPER_INSERT) for a Run Skey, truncate the `run_skey` partition on the following tables based on the availability of data for the run skey.

- `fsi_kicond_accnt_map`
- `fsi_kicond_repline_map`
- `fsi_kicond_accnt_writeoff_map`
- `fsi_kicond_accnt_recovery_map`
