3.1 Obtaining the Software

This release of OFS REG REP RBI 8.0.8.0.0 can be downloaded from <u>My Oracle Support</u>. Log in and search for **30098596** under the Patches and Updates tab.

You must have a valid Oracle account to download the software.

3.2 Prerequisites for Installation

This installer has both upgrade and fresh install capabilities. The following are the prerequisites to install the OFS REG REP RBI application:

NOTE If it is an Upgrade, the minimum patch set level should be OFS REG REP RBI 8.0.2.0.0 (patch **24695583**).

- Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Infrastructure (OFSAAI) 8.0.8.0.0 (patch 29538056), mandatory one-off patch 29952285 plus other prerequisite OFSAAI patches (see Section 2.1 Pre-installation Requirements of OFS AAI Installation Guide) should be installed and configured in your Machine (OHC Documentation Library).
- Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation (OFSDF) 8.0.8.0.0 (patch 29627211), mandatory oneoff patches 30033698 and 30056381 plus other prerequisite OFSDF patches (see Section 3.5.1.1 Installer and Installation Prerequisites of <u>OFSDF Installation Guide</u>) should be installed and configured in your Machine (<u>OHC</u> Documentation Library).
- AgileREPORTER version 19.2.1-b291.
- AgileREPORTER RBI Template package (AgileREPORTER_RBI_Package_v1.22.0.2).
- Ensure that you have executed the .profile file before you trigger the installation.

Ensure that the FICServer is up and running before you trigger the installation. For information on
restarting the services, see the <u>OFS Analytical Applications Infrastructure Release 8.0.2.0.0</u>
<u>Installation and Configuration Guide</u> for more information.

3.2.1 Oracle Database 19c Server and Client Support

The Oracle Database 19c Server and the Client are now supported by the Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Infrastructure (OFSAAI) 8.0.8.2.0 (patch **31365663**). For more information, see the <u>OFS Analytical Applications Infrastructure Release 8.0.8.2.0 Installation Guide</u>.

3.3 Installing OFS REG REP RBI 8.0.8.0.0 Release

Perform the following instructions to download, extract, and install this release patch:

- 1. Download the OFS_REG_REP_RBI_8.0.8.0.0_GENERIC.zip archive file from https://support.oracle.com/ for patch 30098596 under the Patches & Updates tab.
- 2. Copy the archive file to your OFSAA server in **Binary** mode.
- **3.** Shut down all the OFSAA Services. For more information, see the *Stopping Infrastructure Services* section in the <u>OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation</u> <u>Guide – Release 8.0.7.0.0</u>.



Ensure that the **FICSERVER** is up and running.

- 4. Execute chmod -R 750 \$FIC_HOME
- 5. If you have an Unzip utility, skip to the next step.

Download the Unzip utility (OS specific) unzip_<os>.z from the location <u>https://updates.oracle.com/unzips/unzips.html</u> and copy it in **Binary** mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically **\$HOME** path or directory in which you have copied the 8.0.8.0.0 patch.

Uncompress the unzip installer file using the command:

```
uncompress unzip_<os>.Z
```

NOTE If you notice an error message "*uncompress: not found [No such file or directory]*", contact your UNIX administrator.

- 6. Execute chmod 751 OFS_REG_REP_RBI_8.0.8.0.0_GENERIC.zip
- 7. Execute unzip <name of the file to be unzipped>

For example: unzip OFS_REG_REP_RBI_8.0.8.0.0_GENERIC.zip

8. Navigate to the OFS_REG_REP_RBI/conf installer directory containing the template file Silent.template.

- 9. Create a copy of the Silent.template file and rename the copy as Silent.props.
- **10.** Edit the **Silent.props** file and specify the parameters as per the requirements.

- **11.** Execute the user.profile file.
- 12. Navigate to the OFS_REG_REP_RBI/bin directory and execute the following command: ./setup.sh SILENT
- **13.** The installation progress can be viewed by periodically refreshing the log file under the OFS_REG_REP_RBI/logs directory.
- **14.** After installation is completed, verify the log file for any Errors or Warnings. Contact <u>My Oracle</u> <u>Support</u> in case of any issues.

NOTE This patch installation has taken approximately 30 minutes to complete in Oracle Labs.

3.4 Post-installation Steps

The post-installation steps required for this release are:

1. Apply the OFS AAI 33663417 mandatory patch.

ATTENTION	On the 10th of December 2021, Oracle released Security Alert CVE-2021-44228 in response to the disclosure of a new vulnerability affecting Apache Log4J before version 2.15. The application of the 33663417 Mandatory Patch fixes the issue.
	For details, see the My Oracle Support Doc ID <u>2827801.1</u> .
	Ensure that you reapply the 33663417 Mandatory Patch whenever you install or upgrade the application or apply an incremental patch.

- 2. See the log file in the /OFS_REG_REP_RBI/logs directory to ensure that there are no errors reported. Contact <u>My Oracle Support</u> in case of any issues.
- Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application on the configured Web Application Server. For more information about generating and deploying the EAR or WAR file, see the Post Installation Configuration section in the <u>OFS Advanced Analytical Applications</u> <u>Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide – Release 8.0.7.0.0</u>.
- Restart all the OFSAAAI services. For more information, see the Starting Infrastructure Services section in the <u>OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide –</u> <u>Release 8.0.7.0.0</u>.
- 5. Execute the Report-wise batches to Resave and Refresh the Derived Entities.
- Perform the additional configurations if required as mentioned under the Additional Configurations section in the <u>OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Pack Installation Guide –</u> <u>Release 8.0.7.0.0</u>.
