- Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation (OFSDF) 8.0.8.0.0 (patch 29627211), mandatory one-off patches 30033698 and 30056381 plus other prerequisite OFSDF patches (see Section 3.5.1.1 Installer and Installation Prerequisites of OFSDF Installation Guide) should be installed and configured in your Machine (OHC Documentation Library).
- AgileREPORTER version 19.2.1-b291.
- AgileREPORTER RBI Template package (**AgileREPORTER_RBI_Package_v1.22.0.2**).
- Ensure that you have executed the .profile file before you trigger the installation.
