- 2. The installation process might slightly vary depending on the platform / mode if installation (package/net).


2.1 Create Repository in order to Configure the Application

- 1. Install Database.
- 2. Navigate to the directory into which RCU is installed. For Example



1. Download Oracle Webcenter Content 11gR1(Version: 11.1.1.9.0), formerly known as (Oracle Enterprise Content Management) from



- 4. Extract all the files and Install them on the server machine.






