### **Security Best Practices**

- Do not share your Oracle Textura Payment Management username or password with others.
- Enable a verification phone number to better protect your account from unauthorized password changes. Additionally, having a verification phone number will provide the ability to retrieve your username.
- Oracle Support will never ask you for a verification code sent to your phone.
- Designate two Enterprise Administrators for your organization.


### **Data-as-a-Service – tracking deletions improvements**

The **Payment** graph in Data-as-a-Service now includes support for tracking deletions.

- New isDeleted filter added
- New isDeleted Boolean field added
- dataModifiedBegin and dateModifiedEnd filters represent the date a record is deleted.

The **Contract** graph now includes support for tracking deletions of incomplete or unaccepted contracts.

The **Organization Hold** graph now includes filters for dataModified.


## **Summary of Changes**

- The **Track Negative Invoices** project setting will now place submitted positive invoices On Hold to allow for payment adjustments.
- **DocWriter**'s user experience has been improved with smart search functionality and added context to assist PDF sample generations.
- A new **Invoice Line** sub graph is available in Textura Data as a Service (DaaS). **Manual Contract** and **Lien Waiver** graphs now include support for tracking deletions.
- Misc. Bug fixes



## **Tracking Negative Invoices – prevent overpayment**

Payment Holds will now apply not only to the negative invoice itself but also to all positive unpaid invoices for the specific contract.






### **Tracking Negative Invoices – prevent overpayment**


Holds must be manually released:

- Individual holds can be released one at a time from the positive invoices.
- Alternatively, all holds can be released simultaneously when the hold on the negative invoice is removed.








#### **Data-as-a-Service – Invoice Line sub graph**

An **Invoice Line** sub graph is now available to track each invoice line within an invoice.

#### This includes:

- Work This Period, Materials Stored This Period, Retention Amount This Period, Retention Release This Period
- Phase codes, phase code descriptions
- Invoice codes, invoice code descriptions
- .....AND MORE!





### **Data-as-a-Service – tracking deletion**


The **Manual Contractor** and **Lien Waiver** graphs now include support for tracking deletion.

#### **New filter:**

isDeleted

#### New field:

isDeleted






#### Data-as-a-Service - misc bugs addressed

#### Bugs addressed:

- Contract value input via Record Sub-Tiers not persisted in Manual Contract graph
- Slow response for Contract query when filtered by dateModifiedBegin
- One invoice record is now returned for invoices that are exported to ERP multiple times
- Disbursable graph with Payment Holds subgraph failing to return records





#### **Textura - Bug Fixes**

The following bug fixes are resolved with this release:


- Resolved error when closing Draw where integration package doesn't export rejections.
- Resolved an issue with deleting draw.
- Resolved an issue where the Security Banner provided the wrong best practices link.
- Various other minor bugs




