- Be notified of monthly release changes in advance of each release
- Notifications typically go out on the Friday prior to each Sunday release
- We also send out quarterly roundup emails that summarize changes over the prior month





Release Changes in v24.2.0.0

Summary of Changes

- General Contractors can now configure subcontracts to allow contract overbilling.
- The parent organization name is now displayed for all contracts on the Supplier Qualifications tab within Supplier Tracking.
- Enhanced Record Sub-Tiers tracking and workflow.
 - · Parent organizations enter budget and payment for children.
 - Subcontractors are now required to acknowledge when no suppliers are added to a project on Record Sub-Tiers.
- TPA Declined Enrollment Report has been enhanced and renamed to TPA Enrollment Audit Report.
- Enhanced user experience for Subcontractor usage fee retry process.
- Key Bugs Fixed in 24.2.0.0




Subcontracts – allow contract overbilling

Contracts can now be set to allow overbilling. When enabled, invoices submitted can exceed the contract's current value.


Available controls include:

- Organization Setting
- Project Setting
- Contract Setting





Supplier Tracking – parent organization name



The parent organization name is now displayed for all contracts on the Supplier Qualifications tab within **Supplier Tracking**.


Sub-Tiers parent organization name will include the parent's Contract Number in parenthesis.



Record Sub-Tiers – enhanced tracking and workflow

New workflow

- 1. Parent enters Record Sub-Tiers (budget and values) for children.
- 2. Child can Record Sub-Tiers for their children after Parent completes their input.
 - 1. NOTE: Child cannot modify parent entered values.






Record Sub-Tiers – enhanced tracking and workflow

Sub-Tier experience

- 1. Child cannot access Record Sub-Tiers until Parent completes Record Sub-Tiers action.
 - 1. An alert will appear for the Child if Record Sub-Tiers is pending Parent submission.






Record Sub-Tiers – enhanced tracking and workflow


Subcontractor / Sub-Tier acknowledgement

1. All subcontractors are now required to acknowledge if no sub-tiers are participating on the projects during the Record Sub-Tiers workflow.





TPA Enrollment Audit Report



TPA Declined Enrollment Report has been enhanced and renamed to **TPA Enrollment Audit Report**.

Change include:

- New selection criteria for Enrollment Status, Date Range, and Project
- Additional data columns for contact information and enrollment status




Subcontractors – usage fee retry process

The retry fee process for subcontractors has been updated.

Users will notice an updated UI experience, prompting administrators to update payment information if a usage fee has previously failed.

Once payment information has been updated and saved, administrators will be prompted to retry the failed usage fee.





Key Bugs Resolved in 24.2.0.0 release

- Contract Status issues on projects with TPA Split Payments
- Browse Projects organization filter
- Various other minor issues resolved




