- Oracle Fusion Middleware 12cR2 12.2.1.3 has to be installed on the machine.

#### 3.1.2 Steps to Create Domain

# 7. Logging Area

## 7.1 Introduction

This part of the document will talk about the logs area where after deployment of Common Core Applications in WebLogic server.

#### 7.1.1 Logging Area

Common Core Application writes logs in the below area of the server-<WEBLOGIC\_DOMAIN\_CONFIG\_AREA>/servers/CMNCOREAPP/logs/ CMNCOREAPP.out Let's assume a domain has been created **CommonCore\_domain** with **managed\_server** name called **CMNCOREAPP** in the following area of the server

/scratch/oracle/middleware/user\_projects/domains/CommonCore\_domain. Logging area for Common core would be /scratch/oracle/middleware/user\_projects/domains/CommonCore\_domain/servers/CMNCOREAPP/logs/CMNCOREAPP.out.
