1.1 Oracle Banking Party Management

This section covers release information for Oracle Banking Party Management (OBPM) in Release 2.7.0.0.0

Oracle Banking Party Management provides an end-to-end platform to onboard and maintain the party and financial details. The capability caters to all party types such as individuals, organizations and trusts.

It covers customers, members or prospects, affiliates (people associated with the party), service providers and parties associated with applications. It maintains comprehensive party level information to service a customer effectively.

Key capabilities of Oracle Banking Party Management are as follows:

- Onboard Individual, Organization and Trust parties of roles Customer, Member and Affiliates through Customer Onboarding standalone (Fast Path: PI048).
- Onboard Service providers through Service Provider Onboarding (Fast Path: PI028).
- Perform deduplication check once the party data is captured and before the onboarding is done, to avoid creation of duplicate party records.
- Trigger and complete due diligence process, either automatically or by user intervention.
- Perform various servicing events from Single Party View (Fast Path: PI100).
- Interface with the Master Data Management.
- Capture and maintain the financial details of the party.
