### New Users

The new features included in this Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator release are as follows:

- Ability to execute flow from within the Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator user interface.
- Populating the test data automatically from a given Utilities application.
- Support for creating test data sets for a given component.
- Ability to check the changes to a component/product with respect to a Utilities application (useful to check the changes to a component in a new version of Utilities application).
- Ability to create custom runtime configuration per user, as well as at flow level.
- Support for REST web services.
- Improved analytics

## Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator Core

The Oracle Utilities Application Framework flows included in this release are as follows. Two UI sample flows and a web service used to understand the flow creation process are also included.

- F1-ToDoFlow  
A web service flow comprising the creation for ToDo Role, ToDo Type, Add ToDo Entry, Read ToDo Entry, Assign ToDo Entry, and Complete ToDo Entry, and also the completion life cycle of an ToDo.
- F1-BatchExecution  
Demonstrates submitting the batch and receiving back the status.
- F1-BundleImport  
Includes reading the bundle content from the Attachment folder and applying the bundle. It returns the status and ID of the bundle objects in the Oracle Utilities application.
- F1-InitialInstallOption  
Enables the source applications to set installation option(s) values in the Oracle Utilities application.
- F1-OutboundMessageType  
Creates outbound message types.

- F1-XAISender  
Creates an XAI sender in the Oracle Utilities application.
- ToDoFlow (UI Flow)  
Creates ToDo Role, ToDo Type, ToDo Entry, and also to complete the ToDo Entry.
- ToDoRoleFlow (UI Flow)  
A UI flow that includes the Create, Read, Update and Delete operations of ToDo Role.

## Oracle Utilities Customer Care and Billing

The Oracle Utilities Customer Care and Billing work flows included in this Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator release are:

- C1-CreatePremiseAndAccount  
Creates a Premise, Service Point, Person, and Account, collectively referred to as “V” objects.
- C1-StartService  
Creates a meter/meter configuration, meter read, pending start SA (service agreement), and completion of the start service FA before the SA is activated.
- C1-CreateBill  
Generates, freezes, and completes a bill. It uses the C1-BillAdd and C1-BillUpdate components, and an additional F1-SendResultsMail component to be able to notify the user of the test results via an email.
- C1-CreatePaymentEvent  
Creates a Payment Event and also distributes and freezes the payments.
- C1-CloudSanity  
Creates a Person and submits a VAL-PER batch.
- C1-StopService  
Initiates a 'stop service' request. As part of the full 'stop service' flow, steps for creating a final meter read and completion of the stop service FA are included.
- C1-EndToEndStartService  
Creates a Premise, Service Point, Person, and Account, collectively referred to as “V” objects.

- X1-CloudSanity  
Creates a Person and submits a VAL-PER batch.
- X1-CreatePremiseAndAccount  
Creates a Premise, Service Point, Person, and Account, collectively referred to as “V” objects.
- X1-EndToEndStartService

Creates a Premise, Service Point, Person, and Account, collectively referred to as “V” objects.

- X1-CreateBill

Generates, freezes, and completes a bill.

- X1-CreatePaymentEvent

Creates a Payment Event and distributes and freezes the payments.

## Oracle Utilities Meter Data Management/Oracle Utilities Smart Grid Gateway

The Oracle Utilities Meter Data Management work flows included in this Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator release are:

- Demo Interval

Includes creation of a Smart Meter, adding device configuration and interval measuring components to the Smart Meter, loading Initial Measurement Data (IMD) on the meter, and creating usage transactions.

- Demo Scalar

Includes creation of a Manual Meter, adding device configuration and scalar measuring components to the Manual Meter, loading Initial Measurement Data (IMD) on the meter, and creating usage transactions.

The release also includes the following Oracle Utilities Smart Grid Gateway sample flows to understand the flow creation process:

- Itron

Includes creation of an Itron Smart Meter, adding device configuration and scalar measuring components to it, adding the Meter in Itron test harness, and performing various commands on the Meter.

- Landis + Gyr

Includes creation of an LG Smart Meter, adding device configuration and scalar measuring components to it, adding the Meter in LG test harness, and performing various commands on the Meter.

- Echelon

Includes creation of an Echelon Smart Meter, adding device configuration and scalar measuring components to it, creating service point and install event, and performing various commands on the Meter.

- Sensus

Includes creation of an Sensus Smart Meter, adding device configuration and scalar measuring components to it, adding the Meter in Sensus test harness, and performing various commands on the Meter.

- SSN

Includes creation of an SSN Smart Meter, adding device configuration and scalar measuring components to it, adding the Meter in SSN test harness, and performing various commands on the Meter.

- MDM-SGG\_Cloud\_Environment\_Sanity

The MDM-SGG\_Cloud\_Environment\_Sanity flow is used to verify On demand Read scalar for a device on a Cloud environment which is an initial install environment.

## Oracle Utilities Mobile Workforce Management/Oracle Real-Time Scheduler

The Oracle Utilities Mobile Workforce Management work flows included in this Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator release are:

- Non-MDT  
Comprises the creation and completion life cycle of an M1 activity - break, non-productive task (NPT), and real period of unavailability (POU), along with the crew shift.
- MDT  
Includes the creation and completion of an activity, break, non-productive task (NPT), and real period of unavailability (POU) using connected MCP.
- M2 Non-MDT  
Includes the creation and completion of M-Activity (Install Meter Activity, for example).
- MDT Using NextGen MCP  
Includes the creation and completion of an activity, break, non-productive task (NPT), and real period of unavailability (POU) using NextGen MCP.
- MDT Using HybridMCP  
Includes the creation and completion of an activity, break, non-productive task (NPT), and real period of unavailability (POU) using HybridMCP.

## Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management/Oracle Utilities Operational Device Management

The Oracle Utilities Work and Asset Management work flows included in this Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator release are:

- W1-ReorderReview\_Inventory  
Includes the creation and completion life cycle of reorder review and inventory adjustment for inventory.
- W1-ReplicationOfAssets-ODM  
Includes the creation of an asset and uses it as a template asset to replicate multiple assets using the replication activity.
- W1-Material Disposition  
Includes the creation and completion life cycle of work request, work order, activity along with the crew shift, and material request.
- W1-Work Demand  
Includes the creation and completion life cycle of work request, work order, and activity, along with the stock transfer.
- W1-Activity and Activity Reconciliation  
Includes the creation and completion life cycle of activity and activity reconciliation.

## Known Issues

This section lists the issues that were found but not resolved in Oracle Utilities Testing Accelerator at the time of release.

### WS-STARTMULTILIST, WS-ENDMULTILIST and WS-SETVARIABLE keywords

The WS-STARTMULTILIST and WS-ENDMULTILIST keywords are no longer supported. Replace these keywords with WS-SETXMLLISTELEMENT to define component definitions that include complex XML elements. Replace the WS-SETVARIABLE keyword with WS-SETVARIABLEFROMRESPONSE.

### Importing Component/Flow - Progress Status Bar Does Not Reset

The import status progress bar does not reset while importing a component/flow consecutively without refreshing the page. If the page is refreshed after a successful import, the progress status bar works as intended.

You should refresh the page after importing components/flows to be able to see the newly imported components/flows.

During the import process, you may notice errors on the console such as “unable to add entries to the cache”. You may safely ignore these errors.

### Generating Component - Attribute Support

When you generate a component from a WSDL, and if WSDL contains an XML element that has an attribute, the generated component does not reflect this information. You should manually edit the XML element that has the attribute and specify the attribute using the @attribute notation.

### Generating Scripts - No Error Message is Displayed

When you select a flow and click **Generate Scripts**, if the script generation fails, no error message is displayed.

### Custom Content Upgrade

While upgrading flows as part of the custom content upgrade, if a component of the flow is missing in the target product, a new component is created with no definition. The application does not show it as outdated while displaying the new component. The **Outdated** icon does not appear in the display of the flow. Open the new component and add the definition and the test data before using the upgraded flow.
