Oracle Banking does not support Microsoft Internet Explorer Beta, Partner Build or a Release Candi- date. It must be the Final build of Microsoft Internet Explorer. You can view the version information from the Help menu of Internet Explorer. Select 'About Internet Explorer' from the Help menu.



## 1.1 Configuring Internet Options

In order to run Oracle Banking, you need to configure the internet options as follows:

1. Start Internet Explorer. Go to Tools > Internet Options. The 'Internet Options' screen is displayed.



To create shortcut for Oracle Banking payments application browser, follow the steps given below:

- 3. To create a shortcut for Oracle Banking payments login page, specify the location of the item in the following format:

"Location\_of\_Internet\_Explorer" -nomerge "<Application\_URL>"

Eg: "C:\Program Files\Internet Explorer\iexplore.exe" – nomerge "<Application\_URL>"

In this case C:\Program Files\Internet Explorer\iexplore.exe is the location of Internet Explorer.

## 1.3 Setting Compatibility View (IE 11 onwards)

The URL of the Oracle Banking Payments should not be there in the Compatibility View list of the Internet Explorer. You need to follow the URL from compatibility view list by following the steps below:

- 1. Start Internet Explorer. Go to Tools > Compatibility View Settings.
- 2. The following screen is displayed:

## 1.7 Settings for Pop-up Blocker
