# 1. Payments Scripts

The Overview of this document is to share you the PAYMENTS SCRIPTS which require manual execution in the database.

Post FCPayments database installation, below are the list of properties to be updated in the payments table:

1. pmtm\_job\_param.txt script has to be run to insert entries into **PMTM\_JOB\_PARAM** table.

Changes to be done in the script before compiling in the schema:

- If Application Server is Weblogic,

For PM.CTX.PROVIDER property, replace “t3://10.10.10.10:1010” with “t3://Weblogic\_IP:Server\_Port” or “t3://hostname:Server\_Port

- If Application Server is Websphere,

For PM.CTX.FACTORY property, replace “weblogic.jndi.WLInitialContextFactory” in the script with “com.ibm.websphere.naming.WsnInitialContextFactory”.

For PM.CTX.PROVIDER property, replace “t3://10.10.10.10:1010” with “iiop://Websphere\_IP:Bootstrap\_port” or “t3://hostname:Server\_Port

- For PM.CTX.CONNFACTORY the appropriate connection factory needs to be provided for e.g jms/PMQCF.

2. **PMTM\_SYSTEM\_PARAMETERS** table changes to be created/updated in screen PMDSYSPM.

- For PARAM\_NAME “PM.CTX.FACTORY”, update the PARAM\_VALUE as ‘weblogic.jndi.WLInitialContextFactory’ for weblogic and ‘com.ibm.websphere.naming.WsnInitialContextFactory’ for websphere.

For PARAM\_NAME “PM\_CTX\_PROVIDER”, update the PARAM\_VALUE as “t3://Weblogic\_IP:Server\_Port” or ” or “t3://hostname:Server\_Port” for web-logic and

“iiop://Websphere\_IP:Bootstrap\_port” or “” or “t3://hostname:Server\_Port” for web-sphere.

- For PARAM\_NAME “PM.CTX.CONNFACTORY” the appropriate connection factory needs to be provided which is created in JMS Server for e.g jms/PMQCF.
- For PARAM\_NAME “C2B\_FILE\_PATH”, give the C2B path maintained in the server.
- For PARAM\_NAME “DD\_FILE\_PATH” property, give the DD path maintained in the server.
- For PARAM\_NAME “DEBUG\_PATH” property, give the PM DEBUG path maintained in the server.
- For PARAM\_NAME “DISPATCH\_PATH” property, give the DISPATCH path maintained in the server.
