Application Management Pack for Oracle Utilities Network Management System extends Oracle Enterprise Manager Cloud Control to allow monitoring and management of Oracle Utilities Network Management System on remote servers.

When Application Management Pack for Oracle Utilities Network Management System is deployed, the following features and capabilities are available:

- Product discovery
- Target monitoring of status, system load, and activity
- Alerts triggered on monitored thresholds
- Starting and stopping NMS Services
- Sending Action commands to enable/disable debug
- Sending messages to all logged in clients
- Viewing and Downloading service logs
- Isis Snapshots
- Associated targets

### Bug Corrections

This version of the Application Management Pack for Oracle Utilities Network Management System has been updated with the following changes.

- Improved the responsiveness when displaying large data sets within the NMS Activity/Load graphs.
- Corrected an issue with the Critical column values of the NMS Services list. The values were not correctly matching how the service was actually defined in the system.dat file.
- Restored the static inline help text on the Actions dialog.

### Known Issues: Application Management Pack for Oracle Utilities Network Management System

The following are known issues in this release of Application Management Pack for Oracle Utilities Network Management System.

#### Permissions on Agent Installation

Permission issues occur if the agent installation user does not have the proper privileges. It is recommended that the agent be deployed on a user that is a member of the same group as the nmsadmin user.

## Context Sensitive Help

Selecting Help from an Application Management Pack for Oracle Utilities Network Management System page will not bring up the help for that page. You will be required to manually drill in and find the appropriate help page. This is due to a bug (Bug 27736095 - topicId for showing help pages, is not supported in MPCUI JET) in OEM at the time of this release.
