



Your guide to the new features in OPPM 19




Cell Trends Supported for Categories in the Form Module: A new option, **Trend**, is now available for cells within a form. For more details, refer to OPPM Online Help.






Email ID Available as a Tool Tip for User Selection: To differentiate users with identical names, their email ID displays as a tool tip.
