Note: All platforms and technologies certified with a base Unifier version are also supported with the latest Unifier patch set of the platform or technology for that major release (unless specified).

For information on certified platforms for Oracle and other third-party technologies, refer to the certification matrix of the respective technology and select the platform compatible with your Primavera applications and the respective technology.

Oracle has tested on the following configurations and certifies this version to work with these technologies. Customers may choose to use non-certified technologies but do so at their own risk.
