## 3. Installing TopLink 12c

- Open command prompt as administrator
- Set path variable with JDK 7
- Run the following command to run the installer:

```
'java -jar <downloaded path>\toplink_quick_121300.jar'
```

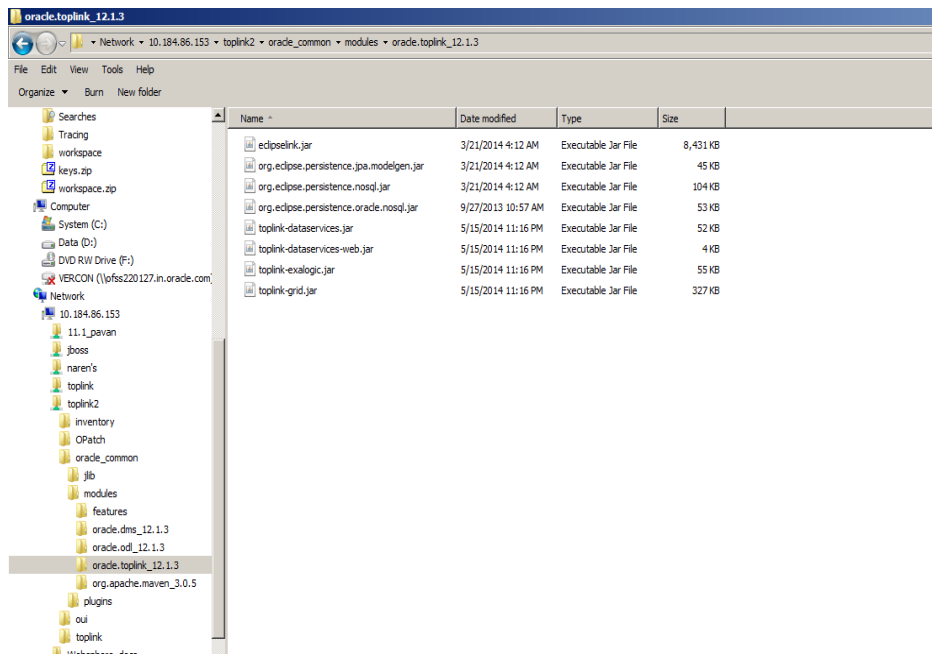

## 4. Configuring TopLink 12c

Create a global shared library containing the following file:

- a) eclipselink.jar

Find this file in the  
'TOPLINK\_INSTALLATION\oracle\_common\modules\oracle.toplink\_ver\_no' directory created  
by the TopLink quick installer.

## **5. Package EclipseLink in the Application EAR**

- Add eclipselink.jar to the application EAR in the following location : EAR\_archive/APP-INF/lib/
- Deploy and start the application
