This Maintenance Release of OFS Data Integration (DI) Application Pack includes all enhancements and bug fixes since the OFS DI Application Pack v8.1.0.0.0 Major release.

NOTE

In an environment consisting of multiple OFSAA applications, if the October 2020 Critical Patch Update is applied for any one application, it is mandatory to apply the respective October 2020 Critical Patch Updates for all other applications on that OFSAA instance, regardless of the application's version. See the My Oracle Support Doc ID 2724021.1 for details.

Pre-Installation Requirements 2.1

The minimum patch set level must be OFS Data Integration (DI) Application Pack v8.1.0.0.0.

NOTE

See the OFS Analytical Applications Technology Matrix, for hardware and software requirements.

Installing this Maintenance Level Release 2.2

To install this ML release, follow these steps:

- 1. Log in to My Oracle Support, and search for patch ID 31959078 under the Patches and Updates tab.
- 2. Download the OFSDI 8.1.0.1.0 <OperatingSystem>.zip archive file and copy it to your OFSAA server in Binary mode.

NOTE

The archive files are different for different operating systems such as AIX, Solaris, and RHEL/Oracle Linux.

- 3. Shut down all the OFSAAI Services. For more information, see the Start or Stop Infrastructure Services.
- 4. Log in to My Oracle Support, search for the 33663417 Mandatory Patch in the Patches & **Updates** Tab and download it.

ATTENTION On the 10th of December 2021, Oracle released Security Alert CVE-2021-44228 in response to the disclosure of a new vulnerability affecting Apache Log4J prior to version 2.15. The application of the 33663417 Mandatory Patch fixes the issue.

- 5. Login to the OFSAA server with the user credentials that were used to install OFS DI.
- **6.** Extract the contents of the OFS DI Application Pack v8.1.0.1.0 in the Download Directory installer archive file using the following command:

```
Unzip -a OFSDI 8.1.0.1.0 <OperatingSystem>.zip
```

NOTE

Rename or remove the existing OFSAA Application Pack folder from the OFSAA server before extracting the contents from the release archive (.zip). For example: For this release, when extracted from the archive a folder with the name OFS_DI_PACK. Is created. Rename or remove if a folder with the same name already exists in the path where the release archive is copied.

- **7.** Give EXECUTE permission to the installer file.
- **8.** Navigate to the path where OFSDI_8.1.0.1.0_<OperatingSystem>.zip is extracted and execute the following command:

```
chmod 750 OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

9. Execute the following software upgrade command:

```
./OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

Verify that the maintenance level release is applied successfully by checking the following log files generated in the installation folder:

- /OFS DI PACK/logs and /OFS DI PACK/OFS DIH/logs folder.
- **10.** You can ignore the following errors in the log files:
 - ORA-00001, ORA-00955, ORA-02260, ORA-01031, and ORA-01430 errors in the log file.
 In case of any other error in the log file, contact My Oracle Support.

2.2.1 Post Installation Steps

Follow these post-installation steps:

- **1.** After successful installation, perform these steps:
 - **a.** Clear the application cache. Navigate to the following path depending on the configured web application server and delete the files:
 - WebLogic

<Weblogic installation location>/domains/<Domain name>/servers/<Server
name>/tmp/_WL_user/<Application name>/<auto generated folder>/jsp_servlet

— WebSphere

<Websphere installation directory>/AppServer/profiles/<Profile name>/temp/<Node
name>/server1/<Application name>/<.war file name>

2. Apply the 33663417 Mandatory Patch.

See the Readme that is packaged with the patch for further instructions on how to install and apply it.

- **3.** Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application onto your configured web application server. For more information, see Create and Deploy the EAR or WAR Files.
- **4.** Start all the OFSAAI services. For more information, see the <u>Start</u> or <u>Stop</u> Infrastructure Services.
