# 2.2.1 Components of Oracle Financial Services Capital Adequacy Application Pack

OFSCAP Application Pack includes the following applications:

- Oracle Financial Services Basel Regulatory Capital Basic: The application encompasses
   Credit, Market, and Operational Risks and provides a detailed breakup of the Capital
   Requirements across various tiers of capital, namely, Common Equity Tier 1, Additional Tier 1,
   and Tier 2 capital. The application supports the computation of Capital Adequacy Ratio (CAR) as
   per Basel III guidelines laid out in the BIS Guidelines. This includes the calculations as per the
   standardized approach of the risk-weighted asset calculations.
- Oracle Financial Services Basel Regulatory Capital Internal Ratings Based Approach: This
  application is based on the approaches supported by the OFS Basel Regulatory Capital Basic
  Application as well as the advanced (or IRB) approaches for BIS.as published by BCBS.

Oracle Financial Services Basel Regulatory Capital Analytics: This application allows
institutions to capitalize on their Basel III compliance investments by providing extensive
dashboards that are used for management outlay and that enable efficient and timely Pillar 2
analysis and Pillar 3 disclosures and provide a complete platform for strategic decision-making
across the institution.

# 2.3 What is New in this Release for OFS CAP ADQ Application Pack

#### 2.3.1 New Features

Starting from release 8.1.1.0.0 of OFS Basel Regulatory Capital Release, we adhere to Basel III: finalizing Post Crisis Reforms (generally code named as Basel IV) compliance for BIS and Australia.

The release at a high level includes the following:

- Basel III: Finalizing Post Crisis Reforms Compliance of BIS Credit Risk Standardized Approach.
- Australia: Finalizing Post Crisis Reforms Compliance of BIS Credit Risk Standardized Approach.
- Changes required for CRR II Compliance of EU for Revised Securitization.
- Market Risk, Large Exposures, and Leverage Ratio compliance for RBI.
- The Retail Pooling functionality is part of the OFS Basel Regulatory Capital IRB product.

The OFS Economic Capital Advanced 8.1.1.0.0 has been enhanced to adhere to the calculations for the Corporate and Retail asset class.

#### **BIS Jurisdiction (BIS)**

As part of this release, the solution is compliant with the Basel III: Finalizing Post Crisis Reforms and the Basel Framework updates for the Credit Risk. The key functionalities addressed in this release are the following:

- Credit Risk
  - Revised Standardized Approach
- Leverage Ratio
  - Revised Leverage Ratio Changes

#### **Australia Jurisdiction (APRA)**

As part of this release, Australian compliance for Capital Adequacy is introduced, and the Post Crisis Reforms compliance is available. This change is on the December 8 draft guideline that is published.

The key functionalities addressed in this release are as below:

- Credit Risk
  - Revised Standardized Approach

#### **European Union Jurisdiction (EBA)**

As part of this release, CRR II functionality related to Revised Securitization is available.

The key functionalities addressed in this release are as below:

- Securitization Risk
  - Revised Approach

#### India Jurisdiction (RBI)

As part of this release, the Market Risk-Related compliance for Basel III is available. It also adheres to the Large Exposures Framework guideline and Leverage Ratio calculations using the Process Modeling Framework.

#### **Retail Pooling**

The retail pooling functionality is available in the OFS Basel Regulatory Capital IRB product, and this adheres to the creation of risk-based pools for retail customers for RWA calculation under the IRB Approach.

#### **OFS Economic Capital Advanced**

The OFS Economic Capital Advanced 8.1.1.0.0 is enhanced with a revised modeling engine to adhere to the calculations for the Corporate and Retail asset class.
