1.1 Audience

The Oracle Financial Services Reconciliation Framework Applications Pack Installation Guide is intended for administrators and implementation consultants who are responsible for installing and maintaining the application pack components.

1.1.1 Prerequisites for the Audience

The document assumes that you have experience in installing Enterprise components and basic knowledge about the following is recommended.

- OFSAA architecture
- UNIX commands

- The web server or web application server
- Oracle Data Integrator

2 OFSAA Reconciliation Framework Application Pack Release 8.1.1.3.0

This Maintenance Release of OFSAA Reconciliation Framework Application Pack includes all enhancements and bug fixes since the OFSAA Reconciliation Framework Application Pack v8.1.1.1.0 Maintenance release.

2.1 Pre-Installation Requirements

The pre-installation requirements in this release of OFSAA Reconciliation Framework are as follows:

- The minimum patch set level must be OFS AAI 8.1.2.6.0.
- The minimum patch set level must be OFSAA Reconciliation Framework Application Pack v8.1.1.2.0 or later.
- Execute the [Pre Installation Script GL RECON 81130](#) in the Config Schema.

NOTE

See the [OFS Analytical Applications Technology Matrix](#), for Hardware and Software Requirements.

2.2 Installing the OFSAA Reconciliation Framework

Perform the following instructions to download, extract, install, and configure this ML Release.

To install this release, follow these steps:

1. Log in to [My Oracle Support](#), and search for patch ID **39625430** under the **Patches and Updates** tab.
2. Download the `OFS_DM_8.1.1.3.0_<OS>.zip` archive file and copy it to your OFSAA server in Binary mode.

NOTE

The archive files are different for every different operating system like Solaris, and RHEL/Oracle Linux.

3. Shut down all the OFSAAI Services. For more information, see [Start](#) and [Stop](#) Infrastructure Services.
4. Login to the OFSAA server with the same user credentials that were used to install the OFSAA Reconciliation Framework Application Pack.
5. Extract the contents of the OFSAA Reconciliation Framework Application Pack v8.1.1.3.0 in the Download Directory installer archive file using the following command:

```
Unzip -a OFS_DM_8.1.1.3.0_<OS>.zip
```

NOTE

Rename or remove the existing OFSAA Application Pack folder from the OFSAA server before extracting the contents from the release archive (.zip). For example: For this release, when extracted from the archive, a folder with the name `OFS_DM_PACK` is created. Rename or remove a folder with the same name if it already exists in the path where the release archive is copied.

6. Give EXECUTE permission to the installer file.
7. Navigate to the path where OFS_DM_8.1.1.3.0_<OS>.zip is extracted and execute the following command:


```
chmod 750 OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```
8. Navigate to the following directory:


```
<>/OFS_DM_PACK
```
9. Update the params.conf file with the **WEBSERVER_TYPE**, for example **Tomcat** and **WEBSERVER_VERSION**, for example **10.1.54**.
10. Navigate to the <>/OFS_DM_PACK and execute the following software upgrade command:


```
./OFSAAIUpdate.sh
```

Verify that the maintenance level release is applied successfully by checking the following log files generated in the installation folder:

 - /OFS_DM_PACK/OFS_GLRECON/logs folder.
11. You can ignore the following errors in the log files:
 - ORA-00001, ORA-00955, ORA-02260, ORA-01031, and ORA-01430 errors in the log file.

2.2.1 Post Installation Steps

Follow these post-installation steps:

1. After successful installation, perform these steps:
 - a. Clear the application cache. Navigate to the following path depending on which web application server is configured and delete the files:
 - **Tomcat:**

```
<Tomcat installation folder>/work/Catalina/localhost/<Application name>/org/apache/jsp
```
 - **WebLogic**

```
<Weblogic installation location>/domains/<Domain name>/servers/<Server name>/tmp/_WL_user/<Application name>/<auto generated folder>/jsp_servlet
```
 - **WebSphere**

```
<Websphere installation directory>/AppServer/profiles/<Profile name>/temp/<Node name>/server1/<Application name>/<.war file name>
```
 - Before creating EAR/WAR copy the file mimepull-1.9.6.jar from ficweb/webroot/WEB-INF/lib to ficweb/webroot/externalib/WEB-INF/lib in case of WebSphere.
2. Modify the sun-jaxws.xml file located at \$FIC_HOME/ficweb/webroot/WEB-INF/ path and comment as mentioned below if the endpoint is enabled,


```
<!--<endpoint
implementation="com.ofs.aai.mdb.ws.service.MetadataBrowserPublishService
```

```
eImpl" name="MetadataBrowserPublishService" url-  
pattern="/mdbPublishExecution"/> -->
```

3. Verify whether the “UploadedExcels” folder exists at the following path. If unavailable, create the folder in the corresponding path.
`${FIC_HOME} /ficweb/webroot/Lookup/UploadedExcels/`
4. Verify whether the ModelDiff.jar is present at the following path and delete it.
`${FIC_HOME}/ficweb/webroot/WEBINF/lib/`
5. Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application onto your configured web application server. For more information, see [Create and Deploy the EAR or WAR Files](#).
6. Start all the OFSAAI services.
