## Chapter 1

## Dashboard Content Reference

Oracle Utilities Analytics provides analysis of the data from Oracle Mobile Workforce Management/Oracle Real-Time Scheduler using Oracle Analytics Server built-in metrics. Nonspatial analytics, information that is not tied to geography, is represented in a series of dashboards showing tables, bar graphs, pie charts, and gauges. Spatial analytics, or information that is geographically related, use Oracle Analytics Server integrated Map Viewer technology to represent activities, emergency events, map data, and other geographical information.

Mobile Workforce Analytics includes metrics that help customers with a mobile workforce to monitor and measure the activities distribution, emergency response time, travel distance deviation, etc.
This chapter describes the Mobile Workforce Analytics' content in the following dashboards:

- Overview
- Activities
- Appointments
- Emergencies
- Travel
- Crew

Note: The Service Area and Crew Hierarchy values have to be configured in the Oracle Mobile Workforce Management/Oracle Real-Time Scheduler application to view the data in Oracle Utilities Analytics Dashboards. ## Overview

The Overview dashboard gives a snapshot of various key performance indicators (KPIs) of the service organization. The dashboard provides you with a quick update on crew utilization, activity management, emergency and appointment response rate, and other details at various mobile worker hierarchy levels.

To access this dashboard:

1. Go to the Home page.
2. Select Dashboards $>$ Mobile Workforce Analytics $>$ Overview.

The dashboard includes the following dashboard pages. The data for current calendar year and month is displayed by default. You may modify the criteria per requirement.

The needle move- <br> ment in the gauge towards yellow or red indicates a need to pay more <br> attention on the crew performance in completing the activities. Hover <br> over the gauge for specific values. <br> Note: The ranges for green, yellow, and red can be <br> customized. |

Hover over the gauge for specific values. <br> Note: The ranges for green, yellow, and red can be <br> customized. |

| Purpose | Business users can get insight into how the shifts are maintained over <br> the previous three months. They can compare the percentages of on- <br> time shifts with that of the previous months. |
| Representation | The gauge shows the percentage, using different colors to denote how <br> the business users perceive the calculated result. The colors yellow or <br> red indicate a need to pay more attention on the shifts that have either <br> late logon or early log off. Hover over the bar for specific values. <br> Note: The ranges for green, yellow, and red can be <br> customized. |
| Drill Down | The gauge drills down to the Shift Timeliness dashboard page for <br> specific shift details. |

Hover over the <br> gauge for specific values. <br> Note: The ranges for green, yellow, and red can be <br> customized. |

| Drill Down | The graph bars drill down to the Travel Distance dashboard page for <br> specific travel distance details. |

The needle move- <br> ment in the gauge towards yellow or red indicates that appointments <br> are missed, and need to pay more attention on the crew appointment <br> management. Hover over the gauge for specific values. <br> Note: The ranges for green, yellow, and red can be <br> customized. |

| The table shows the number of scheduled and completed activities, |  |
| along with the percentage of completion per each month. |  |

## Completed Activities Distribution

| Description | This analysis shows the percentage of completed activities by service <br> category for the selected month. |
| Purpose | Business users can analyze the category in which most of the activities <br> were completed, and that with minimum completions to take <br> necessary actions. |
| Representation | The pie chart shows the distribution of completed activities <br> categorized under the selected service category. |
| The Service Category drop down in the table slices the data by <br> various service categories. |  |
| The table displays a list of completed activities by the selected service <br> category and activity types within the service area hierarchy. |  |

## Multi-Attempt Activities

| Representation | The pie chart shows the distribution of multi-attempt activities across <br> various service categories. |
| The Service Category drop down filters the data per the selected <br> service category. |  |
| The table displays a list of completed activities and the number of <br> attempts for each activity completed. The data is categorized by <br> service category (selected in the pie chart) and activity types within <br> the service area hierarchy. |  |
| Drill Down | The pie chart segments show the master-detail interaction with the <br> table in this analysis. Clicking on a specific segment refreshes the table <br> to show the data for the specific Service Category. |

## Duration Deviation by Service Category

## Activities Map

The Activities Map dashboard page provides a spatial representation of completed activities and their distribution as per work duration deviation buckets. In addition, for each postal code, a mini pie chart displays the work duration deviations of the activities in that postal code.

| Description | This analysis provides a geographical view to quickly identify the <br> count of activities in a specific region, and the work duration <br> deviations for those activities. The data is shown for the selected <br> month. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Purpose | Using this map view, business users can view activity volumes in <br> postal codes and their work duration deviations. |
| Representation | The color-coded region on the map shows the postal code of that <br> geographical region and the number of completed activities per <br> month in that postal code. The postal codes are colored based on the <br> number of activities, which can be configured by the user in the <br> legend. |
| The map also shows pie charts, one per postal code. Each pie chart <br> displays the number of activities in the respective work duration <br> buckets. The work duration link drills down to show lower level <br> details. |  |
| The table shows the number of activities against each activity type <br> that are categorized under each service category. The data is shown <br> per postal code. |  |
| Drill Down | The Postal Code link broadcasts the region details and drills down to <br> the Multi-Attempt Activities, Deviations, and Canceled and |
